

Conducted September 22-26, 2022 under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R), this Fox News poll includes interviews among 1,008 Arizona registered voters who were randomly selected from a statewide voter file and spoke with live interviewers on both landlines and cellphones. Interviews were conducted by bilingual interviewers and respondents were given the option of completing the survey in English or Spanish.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus 3 percentage points. Results among the attached subgroups have larger sampling errors:
