Questions 1-56 and 61-65 are for release after 9:00 AM/ET Sunday, October 16, 2022. Questions 57-60 are for release after 6:00 PM/ET Tuesday, October 18, 2022.

## Methodology

Conducted October 9-12, 2022, this Fox News Poll includes interviews among 1,206 registered voters (RV) nationwide who were randomly selected from a national voter file and spoke with live interviewers. Landline (186) and cellphone $(1,020)$ telephone numbers were selected for inclusion using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $\pm 2.5$ percentage points.
The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw \& Company Research (R).

Fox News Polls before 2011 were conducted by Opinion Dynamics Corporation.

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted. An asterisk (*) is used for percentages of less than one-half percent. A dash (-) represents a value of zero.
Some percentages may not add to $100 \%$ due to rounding. In the same way, percentages in "total" columns may be one point more or less than the sum of their parts due to rounding.
