

Questions 4, 8-9, 26A, 30-50 are for release after 6:00 PM/ET Wednesday, October 11, 2023. Questions 1-3, 5-7, 10-26, 27-29 are for release after 6:00PM/ET Thursday, October 12, 2023 All other results are held for future release.

## Methodology

Conducted October 6-9, 2023, this Fox News Poll includes interviews among 1,007 registered voters (RV) nationwide who were randomly selected from a national voter file and spoke with live interviewers. Landline (156) and cellphone (851) telephone numbers were selected for inclusion using a probability proportionate to size method, which means phone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of $\pm 3$ percentage points.
The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw \& Company Research (R).

Fox News Polls before 2011 were conducted by Opinion Dynamics Corporation.

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.
