

Conducted February 25-28, 2024 under the joint direction of Beacon Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R), this Fox News national poll includes interviews among 1,262 registered voters who were randomly selected from a national voter file and spoke with live interviewers on landlines and cellphones, or completed the survey online after receiving an invitation by text message. Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus 2.5 percentage points. Results among the attached subgroups have larger sampling errors:
