#### PETER SCHULMEISTER Solo Violin

Born in 1977, he studied with Victor Tretyakov in Cologne and also with Igor Ozim, Vladimir Spivakov, Joseph Silverstein, the Melos Quartet and Shmuel Ashkenasi. He has won top prizes in music competitions in Germany, Italy and Portugal and has been awarded scholarships by the Habisreutinger Foundation, Zürich, and the Bavarian RSO, Munich. He has performed as guest leader with the LPO and appears as guest concert master with the Bamberg Symphony Orchestra, Berlin Radio Symphony Orchestra, Kurpfalz Chamber Orchestra, Mannheim, and Württemberg Chamber Orchestra, Heilbronn. In 2001 he was a member of the Amar Quartet, Zürich. He was awarded the Deutsch-Russischer Kulturpreis für Musik by the State of Baden-Württemberg. In the 2007/8 Season he joined the Orchestra of the Royal Opera House as Associate Concert Master.

#### MARCO BEHTASH Solo Double Bass

Born in California, Marco Behtash is currently the second Principal bass with the Orchestra of the Royal Opera House. He started playing the double bass at age 14, guided by Shinji Eshima of the San Francisco Opera. He furthered his studies at the SF Conservatory with Scott Pingel and later at Guildhall School of Music & Drama, completing his Master's degree in 2014 with Rinat Ibragimov and Luis Cabrera. He has played with orchestras including the Royal Concertgebouw Orchestra, the London Symphony Orchestra, San Francisco Symphony, Rotterdam Philharmonic, Netherlands Philharmonic and Chamber Orchestras. In 2016 he joined the Orchestra of the Royal Opera House as Sub-Principal bass, and was promoted in 2022 to his current position.

Commercial photography and filming must be agreed in advance with our press team.

Larger bags and backpacks need to be check into our complimentary cloakrooms. Unattended bags may be removed. Please do not place any personal belongings on the ledges in front of you.

If you arrive late to the auditorium or leave during a performance, you will not be allowed back to your seat until the interval or a suitable break.

Our staff are committed to treating everyone with dignity and respect and we ask that you show them and your fellow audience members respect too.
