2024 National Black Voter Project: Select Toplines

As we look toward the 2024 general election, new results from the latest Black Voter Project (BVP) public opinion survey offer unique insight into Black political attitudes and behavior. The survey (in collaboration with Black Insights Research) is the latest poll in the Black Voter Project series of surveys born out of a desire to emphasize the instrumental role Black voters play in our understanding of American politics. The survey is a national (nonpartisan) public opinion poll that focuses on collecting rigorous and representative data of Black Americans, something seldom found in Beltway polling.

The 2024 National Black Voter Project (BVP) survey was administered online based on randomly selected email addresses from lists of panel respondents who identify as African-American or Black. An online questionnaire was fielded from March 29 – April 18, surveying respondents about the 2024 general elections. A total of 2,004 African-American or Black respondents were interviewed, and the survey had an average interview length of 18 mins. The survey, administered by YouGov, was stratified across age, education, gender, and region, collecting a nationally representative sample of respondents from all 50 states. The survey serves as the first of a multi-wave longitudinal study collecting recontact data in the months leading up to the election.
