
This Court, having reviewed Petitioner’s Application for Relief under C.R.S. § 6-1-109 For Failure to Respond to Civil Law Enforcement Investigative Subpoena, and the supporting documents attached therein, without any objection being filed following service of the Application, and being fully advised on the premises, and finding good cause,

HEREBY ORDERS that:

- (1) Pursuant to C.R.S. § 6-1-110(1)(a) & (c), Jones & Associates Law Group, LLC (“Jones & Associates”) shall refrain from advertising services or entering into contracts with consumers until it complies with the subpoena served by Petitioner, the State of Colorado, by and through Cynthia H. Coffman, Attorney General (the “State”);
- (2) Pursuant to C.R.S. § 6-1-109(1)(b), Jones & Associates shall provide all documents responsive to the State’s subpoena within seven days of the date of this order; and
- (3) Pursuant to C.R.S. § 6-1-113(4), Jones & Associates shall pay the attorney fees and costs that the State incurred in having to file the application. The State shall file an affidavit of attorney fees and costs within 14 days of the date of this order.
