This Court, having reviewed Petitioner’s *Application for Relief Under C.R.S. § 6-1-109 For Failure to Respond to Civil Law Enforcement Investigative Subpoena*, and the supporting documents attached therein, being fully advised on the premises, and finding good cause,


HEREBY ORDERS that Randy Jensen HomeCare, LLC and Randy Jensen shall:

- (1) Refrain from engaging in or advertising that they engage in equity purchasing and foreclosure consulting activities until Randy Jensen HomeCare complies with the subpoena served by Petitioner, the State of Colorado (the “State”), by and through the Attorney General, pursuant to C.R.S. § 6-1-110(1);
- (2) Produce all documents responsive to the State’s subpoena within seven days of the date of this order pursuant to C.R.S. § 6-1-109(1)(b); and

(3) Pay the reasonable attorneys' fees and costs that the State incurred in having to file the application. The State shall file an affidavit of attorneys' fees and costs within 14 days of the date of this order pursuant to C.R.S. § 6-1-113(4).
