## It's Safe for Law Enforcement to Give Help: Responding to scenes with suspected fentanyl or other opioids.

- Naloxone works to reverse fentanyl overdoses.
- Start chest compressions if there is no heartbeat.
   Support breathing if slow or no breathing.
- Wait 2-3 minutes between giving naloxone doses.
- If concerned about a potential drug exposure, call your local Poison Center at 1-800-222-1222.
