# LLOYD BRUCE-BURGESS

# **Head Coach - First Season**

Lloyd Bruce-Burgess brings experience coaching men's tennis at lowa, South Florida, Wichita State and Fresno Pacific—plus two seasons at UCF as assistant women's tennis coach—to his new assignment as head men's tennis coach for the Knights.

Bruce-Burgess continues his collaboration with newly named UCF director of tennis Bryan Koniecko whose Knight women's tennis team has advanced to the NCAA Championship each of the last two seasons with Bruce-

Burgess' assistance.

"Lloyd has a great reputation nationally as a rising star," said vice president and director of athletics Terry Mohajir. "We're thrilled for him to lead our men's tennis team, while continuing to work with Coach Koniecko in building conference and national championship caliber programs."

"I am honored and delighted to accept the position of head men's tennis coach," said Bruce-Burgess. "I would like to express my sincere gratitude to Bryan, (deputy athletics director) Abby (Wilson), and Terry (Mohajir) for trusting me with this opportunity.

"I also want to acknowledge the outstanding work of John Roddick, who has established UCF as a nationally recognized tennis program. I am eager and excited to begin working with the team and embark on a new journey in the history of UCF tennis. Charge On!"

Roddick announced his resignation Friday after seven seasons as UCF director of tennis and men's tennis head coach.

In Bruce-Burgess' first season with the Knights in 2022, the squad posted a 16-8 record and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Championship. UCF was the top seed in the American Athletic Conference Championship Tournament in his first season and reached the final of that event. His second season with UCF in 2023 also concluded with another NCAA Championship team appearance, as well as two players named to the AAC all-league team and a national ranking of 14th. UCF players in each of his seasons rated as the highest-ranked singles players in the league.

Under Bruce-Burgess' guidance, Marie Mattel earned two consecutive berths to the NCAA Singles Championship and was ranked as high as No. 30 in the Intercollegiate Tennis Association singles polls. Koniecko and Bruce-Burgess combined in 2023 to sign the second-ranked recruiting class in the country (by tennisrecruting.net), including two top-five-rated United States players.

"I am thrilled to announce that Lloyd will be the next men's tennis coach at UCF," said Koniecko. "Lloyd has been a valuable member of our staff for the last two years, and his passion for excellence is unparalleled. He has an impressive tennis background, with experience in coaching, playing, and recruiting. Lloyd is someone who genuinely cares for his players and will work tirelessly to build a championship team at UCF for years to come. I look forward to seeing him lead our program to new heights."

Bruce-Burgess was named the UCF women's tennis assistant coach in July 2021. He came to UCF after two seasons as an assistant men's tennis coach at the University of Iowa, where in 2021 he helped the doubles team of Oliver Okonkwo and Will Davies to a No. 2 national ranking, the highest an Iowa doubles team has been ranked in program history. Okonkwo and Davies qualified for the NCAA Championship as the seventh doubles duo to do so in program history.

Under Bruce-Burgess' leadership, Kareem Allaf earned first-team All-Big Ten accolades for the second straight season in 2021 and became lowa's all-time leader in wins, and Davies tied the program record for most doubles victories. In his first season at lowa, Bruce-Burgess helped coach the Hawkeyes to a 12-2 start in 2020 and a program-best national ranking of No. 20--and the Hawkeyes were on pace to qualify for the program's first NCAA

Championship before the season was canceled due to Covid-19.


Prior to Iowa, Bruce-Burgess served a short stint as an assistant at the University of South Florida for the 2019 fall campaign after serving as director of tennis for Genesis Health Clubs from 2013-19. He received director of the year honors within the health club system in 2015 and 2016.

Bruce-Burgess previously coached professional tennis, working with Johnanna Konta and Renata Zarazua on the Women's Tennis Association tour. He served as a practice partner for Konta, who was ranked as high as No. 3 on the WTA tour and was a finalist in an Australian Open.

Bruce-Burgess spent one year in 2014 as a part-time volunteer assistant men's tennis coach at Wichita State (18-9 record) after a year in 2013 as assistant men's and women's coach at Fresno Pacific. The Fresno Pacific men that year ranked No. 1 in the NAIA and the women third, as the program transitioned to NCAA Division II.

A native of Brockenhurst, England, Bruce-Burgess earned his communication studies degree in 2012 from Fresno Pacific where he was a part of the 2012 NAIA national runner-up squad (25-2 team mark). He was a two-time JUCO All-American at Cowley College (Arkansas City, Kansas) where he was ranked No. 3 and No. 2 by the NJCCA in singles and doubles, respectively, on a team ranked sixth nationally. He was also tabbed the ITA Region VI Player of the Year in 2010 thanks to records of 21-2 in singles and 14-8 in doubles.

As a junior player in the United Kingdom, Bruce-Burgess was ranked among the top 50 men's players. In 2007, he qualified for the men's British Tour Masters (the top 32 players in the country).









# KAREEM **ALLAF**

### **Assistant Coach - First Season**

The UCF men's tennis program has announced the addition of Kareem Allaf as an assistant coach ahead of the 2023-2024 season, head coach Lloyd Bruce-Burgess announced Thursday.

Allaf, who played five seasons at the University of Iowa from 2016-21,

he owns the program record in singles and doubles victories with 164 combined triumphs. Additionally, Allaf represented the Syrian National Team at the Davis Cup, and he will reunite with his former coach in Orlando following a year stint as a volunteer assistant at Mississippi State.

"I am thrilled to be welcoming Kareem to our team. Having seen his development as a player at Iowa, as a professional player and entering the collegiate coaching ranks at Mississippi State, I have no doubt how valuable of an asset he will be to the growth of our program. We are extremely fortunate to have him at UCF and I can't wait to embark on this journey with him."

Prior to Allaf's announcement, the Iowa graduate had been playing on the Association of Tennis Professionals (ATP) Tour, most recently at the M15 Champaign alongside A.J. Catanzariti. Allaf holds a career-high ATP doubles rank of 704, attained this August following a run to the semifinals at the M25 Southaven. In July, Allaf advanced to the doubles finals at the M25 Edwardsville following a quarterfinal victory over former Knight Trey Hilderbrand and Noah Schachter. In singles, Allaf rose to as high as No. 751 in May of this year.

As Bruce-Burgess embarks on his first season as a collegiate head coach, Allaf will serve as a familiar companion, with the two having previously spent time together with the Hawkeyes from 2020-21. At lowa, Allaf consistently grew into one of the nation's top players, earning three All-Big Ten honors, with his second consecutive first-team selection garnered while Bruce-Burgess was serving as an assistant coach. His 2021 dual-match season engraved Allaf into the record books, as the Syrian native recorded 10 singles wins on court one including three triumphs over ranked opponents. A remarkable 95 career singles and 69 career doubles wins, which rank second and third in school history in each category, respectively.

"I am very humbled to have this opportunity to be joining UCF as a coach and embrace a new role," said Allaf on the announcement. "I am very excited to get to know the team and help the program in any way I can. Go Knights!"

During his collegiate career, Allaf tallied 12 career singles victories over ranked opponents. His 22 doubles victories as a sophomore in 2018 remain third on Iowa's single-season wins list, while 23 singles victories during his freshman campaign in 2017 tie for the 11th most in a single season in the program's history.

In 2018, Allaf became the third player in program history to win the ITA Central Regional Singles Championship following victories over No. 39 and No. 45 ranked opposition. A year later, Allaf won four straight singles matches at the ITA Central Regionals to qualify for the national event, going on to defeat two nationally-ranked opponents to qualify for the ITA Main Draw, becoming just the second Hawkeye to accomplish the feat.

During the 2019 Davis Cup, Allaf led the Syrian National Team through a strong group stage performance. With victories on court two over opponents from Qatar, Malaysia and Iran, Allaf was vital in one of the most successful competitions in the nation's history.

Allaf graduated from the University of Iowa with a degree in Enterprise Leadership and a minor in communications before securing his masters in sports and recreational management.







# ANDY GLADSTONE

# **Director of Ops - Second Season**

The UCF men's and women's tennis programs hired Andrew Gladstone as the Director of Operations for both programs in September of 2022.

Gladstone spent 20 years working for the USTA as an administrator, where he worked with professional tennis players such as Reilly Opelka, Sloane Stephens, Amanda Anisimova, Danielle

Collins, and Nicole Melichar. Along with working for the USTA, Gladstone also was a ball boy at the US Open for several years. Gladstone's family was voted as USTA Florida's Family of the Year in 2008.

Over the summer of 2022, Gladstone was a tennis coach for the Maccabiah Games in Israel, which is an event held every four years and is ranked as the third largest sporting event in the world measured by the number of athletes.

Gladstone's family includes his wife along with a son and a daughter. His wife is a leader in the United States as a 10 and under Tennis coach and is also holds the record for all time wins at the University of South Carolina. His son who attended the creative school at UCF back in preschool, got his master's degree in math and is now a Tennis coach in Jacksonville.

Gladstone's daughter played four years of College Tennis at Davidson and graduated in 2022, which is considered to be the same graduating class as 4x NBA Champion Stephen Curry. During his time at USTA, Gladstone became personal friends with College Basketball Commentator Dick Vitale. Dick would often call Gladstone to find out the rankings of his grandchildren, who played Tennis at USTA.

Along with being a passionate Tennis player and fan, Gladstone loves to read business, motivational, and sports books in his free time. His new kindle reader has become very importantin his life. Gladstone also loves to run and go to fitness centers.







# **USTA National Campus**



The UCF Knights play their home matches at the UCF Collegiate Tennis Center at the USTA National Campus in Lake Nona, Florida. Both the UCF men's and women's tennis teams have played here since the campus opened in 2017.

The complex's UCF Collegiate Tennis Center features 12 plexicushion courts with seating for 1,200 fans and room for additional seating areas. It is large enough to allow two collegiate matches to be played simultaneously. The area also features a two-story pavilion including concessions and locker rooms.

Looked upon as one of the greatest facilities in the country, the NCAA agreed to host the NCAA team, singles and doubles championships at the UCF Collegiate Tennis Center in 2019, 2021 and 2021. The 2019 & 2021 championships were a hit to tennis fans throughout central Florida, as was the College MatchDay series. Televised on the Tennis Channel, elite tennis programs from across the country would compete in a highly-attended rivalry match at the USTA National Campus. The series plans to continue on making its home in Orlando. The American Athletic Conference championship tournament was also held at the collegiate tennis center in 2019.

In addition to the UCF Collegiate Tennis Center, the USTA National campus is home to over 100 tennis courts. The venue not only provides student-athletes the best of playing surfaces, but other hands on experiences to complement what they learn in the classroom.

The United States Tennis Association (USTA) established this tennis center to welcome all levels of players. This includes youth that are just beginning to learn the game all the way to professional players. Construction was finished on the tennis center in late 2016.

The USTA Player Development division moved its national headquarters from Boca Raton to Orlando, aiming to provide the best opportunities to succeed for the next generation of American tennis champions.

"This new home for American tennis will truly be a gamechanger for our sport," said USTA chairman of the board and president Dave Haggerty, "This world-class facility will be an inclusive gathering place for American tennis and will allow us to impact our sport at every level, from the grassroots to the professional ranks."

Along with many partners, the university will help raise private funds to contribute to the development of the center. UCF also is exploring opportunities to connect its academic programs and students with the center's operations.

Former UCF President John C. Hitt joined Haggerty, Gov. Rick Scott, Orange County Mayor Teresa Jacobs and Orlando Mayor Buddy Dyer were all a part of this process. Officials from Tavistock Group, the developer of Lake

Nona, also participated. "UCF has embraced this project because it impacts academics, community partnerships, economic development and athletics," Hitt said. "Our students, our tennis players and our entire community will benefit from having the finest tennis facilities in the country at Lake

This new home for American tennis hosts every type of tennis event from 10-and-under team tennis events to national championships for those aged 90 and older. Additionally, the facility is conveniently located near the Orlando International Airport to accommodate visiting tennis players.

"More than a decade ago we undertook a strategic plan for the development of the southeast sector of our city," Dyer said. "The selection of Orlando for the United States Tennis Association's new divisional headquarters further enhances this area and speaks to the value of our community's assets-a talented labor force, businessfriendly environment and global access via a world-class airport.'

"Lake Nona is founded on the principles of innovative collaboration and inspiring human potential," said Rasesh Thakkar, senior managing director of Tavistock Group. "This campus at Lake Nona has all of the ingredients for the beginnings of a world-class sports and human performance cluster with the USTA setting the bar."
