




TeamWork U Exclusive Zoom Call

Major League Sports Ticket Sales Virtual Career Fair



TeamWork launched the Major League Sports Ticket Sales Virtual Career Fair and welcomed TeamWork U current seniors and recent graduates interested in ticket sales to apply to participate. Every candidate had to submit an application, a Spark Hire video, a professional reference and cover letter in order to be chosen. The final 102 had the opportunity to complete 1Huddle Sales Training, hear from top HR Execs and former NBA Job Fair hires as well as meet with 70+ employers in Zoom breakout rooms. Following the events, employers were given access to their applications and have since set up many conversations and interviews. As of June 6, 40 out of 102 finalists were hired for jobs.
