Privacy Policy

The Techfugees Foundation takes your privacy seriously. Your personal information will not be sold or otherwise distributed to third parties without your consent. The Techfugees Foundation is not a source of unsolicited email.

What Our Privacy Policy Covers

This policy covers what personal information The Techfugees Foundation collects, how that information is collected and why we need it. Personal information is information about you that is personally identifiable like your name, address, email address, or phone number, and that is not otherwise publicly available. This policy does not cover the practices of companies other than The Techfugees Foundation or people who are not employed or managed by The Techfugees Foundation. Third party sites provide the products and services listed on The Techfugees Foundation and these sites have their own privacy statements and are not covered by this policy.

What Information We Collect and How We Use It

Providing your email address to The Techfugees Foundation is optional and used solely to update you with new products and services that we have to offer, or to respond to and queries you have sent The Techfugees Foundation automatically receives and records information on our server logs from your browser, including your IP address, browser type, and the page(s) you request. This information is collected anonymously and is used to better understand how people use our site and improve its performance.

Who Has Access to Your Information

As a matter of policy The Techfugees Foundation does not sell, rent, share or otherwise distribute any of your personal information to third parties except in certain specific circumstances. Those circumstances are as follows:

- We receive a subpoena, court order or other legal demand for your information.
- We believe it is necessary to share information in order to investigate, prevent or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, or as otherwise required by law.
- The Techfugees Foundation is acquired by or merged with another company. In this event The Techfugees Foundation will notify you before your information is transferred and becomes subject to a different privacy policy.
- Some of our services allow you to make certain information public or accessible to certain individuals. If you make use of these services The Techfugees Foundation will share your information as you request.

Financial information

If you wish to pay for your delegate pass(es) by credit or debit card, we will require your credit or debit card number and expiry date in order to take the payment. Your financial information is used solely for this purpose. As part of payment processing, your financial information will be passed to a credit card processing company (currently PayPal or Stripe). No record of your financial information will be held on the Site or otherwise by us following the processing of your payment. The credit card processing company does not use, share, retain or store this information for any purpose, other than to process your payment for the above purpose.
