



ENHANCING THE CLUB EXPERIENCE.....

CLUB OFFICER RESPONSIBILITIES CAN BE A BALL

Supplies or Equipment List:

- Inflatable beach ball
- Printed labels of questions to place randomly on the beach ball

Handouts:

- Club Officer Responsibility questions (printed on Avery 5160 labels and placed randomly on the beach ball)

Notes for Instructor: Prior to the activity, print out the review questions provided on Avery 5160 labels. Inflate the beach ball and place the printed labels randomly on the beach ball.

Lesson Plan Content:

- This activity is a review for the content learned during the “Club Officer Responsibilities” lesson.
- Have the members of the group arrange their chairs so that they are sitting in a circle, facing each other.
- Toss the labeled, inflated beach ball to one of the participants.
- Instruct them that as they catch the beach ball, they need to read the question that is closest to their left thumb aloud.
- After reading the question, provided an answer(s) to the question.
- After completion of the question, toss the beach ball to another member of the group and have that person answer the question closest to their left thumb.
- Continue until either all of the questions have been answered or all of the participants have had a chance to have the beach ball.

Wrap Up/Conclusion:

- Learning can be made fun.
- What other ways can you share club officer duties with 4-H club officers in a way that is fun for them to learn?
