Watch Tyler Perry (!) Steal a Movie Without a Fat Suit

So did you ever suggest changing the title of Gone Girl to Tyler Perry's Gone Girl? [laughs] No, absolutely not. I'm pretty sure that between David Fincher and the history of the book itself, that movie's gonna be fine. It doesn't need any help from Tyler Perry.
