With the POTUS announcement of today's successful strike at the heart of AQ, I'd ask us all to have our antenna up to anticipate the reaction of AQ and its affiliated groups as well as like-minded groups or individuals who may opt to retaliate, whether it be in the homeland, Afghanistan/Pakistan or elsewhere in the world. That retaliation might occur in the coming days through self radicalization and the insider threat, acceleration of active plots, or immediate visceral reaction by individuals or groups - or perhaps occur weeks, months or years down the road. We'll need to work hard to understand the impact of this event on AQ and its affiliates and how they will likely respond while indentifying the opportunilies and challenges the have now been presented to us.

This was an incredibly deadly held operation and its nice to know good OPSEC practices can still work. Well done to the hunters and those who supported them in bringing this terrorist and murderer to his ultimate and accountable end. Justice sometimes take much longer then we would like, but America doesn't quit. A great day and one we have long been working toward. The fight will go on but again, well done and keep the analysis and reporting flowing.
