ABOUT DATA

Data in this report is from the **2020 U.S. Census Bureau Public Use Microdata (PUMS) and the 2020 American Community Survey, 5 Year**. Every decade ending in zero (e.g., 2010 or 2020), the U.S. Census Bureau counts the number of living people in the United States. This count is known as a **true count**. Therefore, data within this report is a true count of the veteran population. The term, **veteran**, is defined by the U.S. Census Bureau as, "men or women who have served (even for a short time), but are not currently serving, on active duty in the U.S. Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, or the Coast Guard, or who served in the U.S. Merchant Marine during World War II. People who served in the National Guard or Reserves are classified as veterans only if they were ever called or ordered to active duty, not counting the 4-6 months for initial training or yearly summer camps."

Measuring Communities is a free data tool that houses over 60 health and social indicators for the military-connected population across the nation. DATA CONSIDERATIONS

Data regarding the veteran population in states and counties can be valuable to help target outreach efforts as well as consider how different programs may be applied throughout the state. It is important to note that publicly available data, while beneficial, has limitations:

- This data includes permanent state and county residents, and likely does not include seasonal or transitory residents.
- The population included in this report is the veteran population, as defined by the U.S. Census Bureau. Therefore, this definition does not include currently serving military members, including currently serving National Guard or Reserve populations. It should also be noted that National Guard or Reserve members are considered veterans (through this definition) only if they were "ever called or ordered to active duty, not counting the 4-6 months for initial training or yearly summer camps" (U.S. Census Bureau).
- Age ranges included in this report are consistent with the groupings from the U.S. Census Bureau.
- National data in this report includes all 50 states; the District of Columbia; Guam; Puerto Rico; and the U.S. Virgin Islands. Data from Guam and the U.S. Virgin Islands is from the 2010 PUMS data.
- While data is a true count from the U.S. Census Bureau, percentages for data indicators may not add up to exactly 100%. This is due to a natural margin of error in population totals and counts.
- Some data at the county level is very small. To protect against the risk of potentially identifiable information, all raw count data between "1" to "9" is indicated as "less than 10."
- Data regarding LGBTQ+ individuals is not currently available through the U.S. Census Bureau.

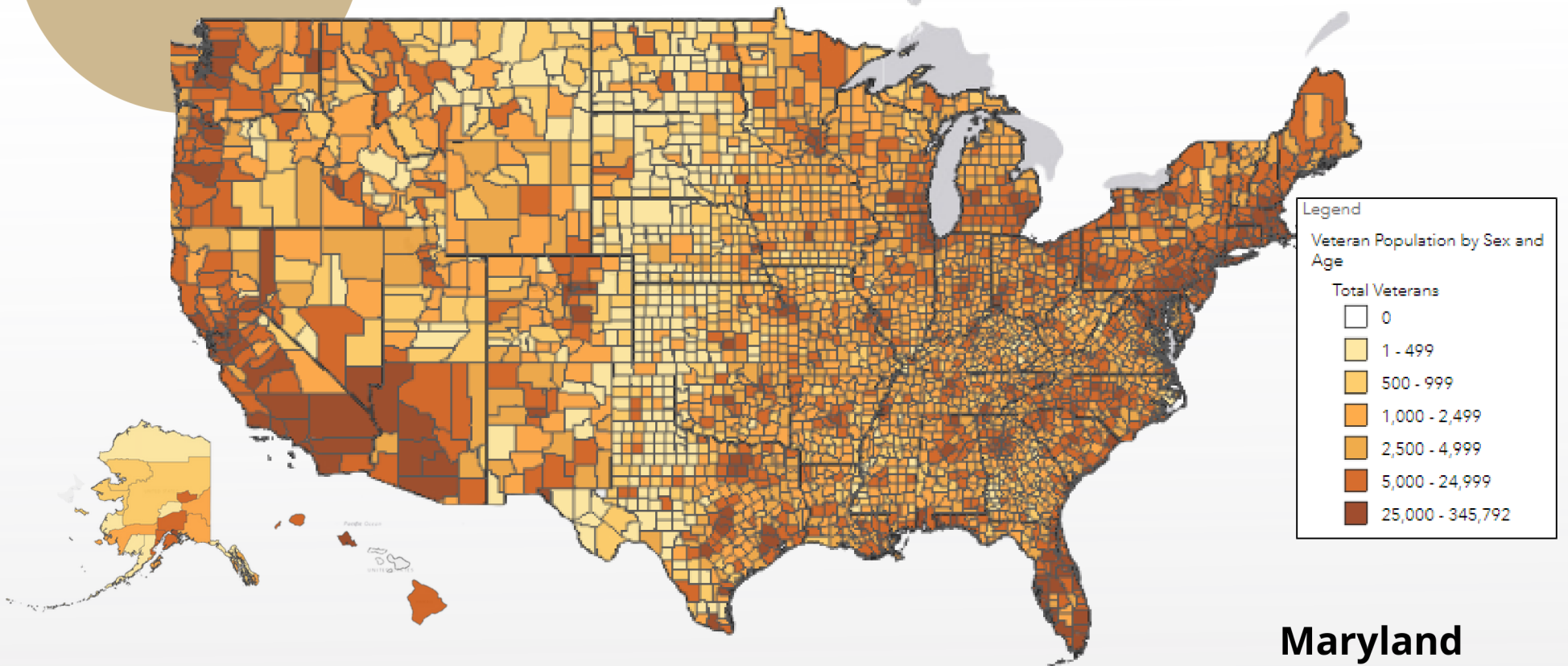

Veteran Population by Sex and Age

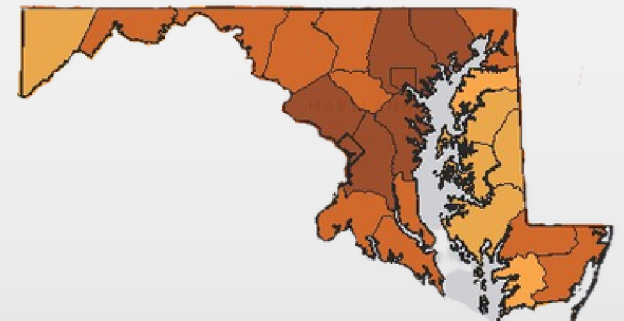



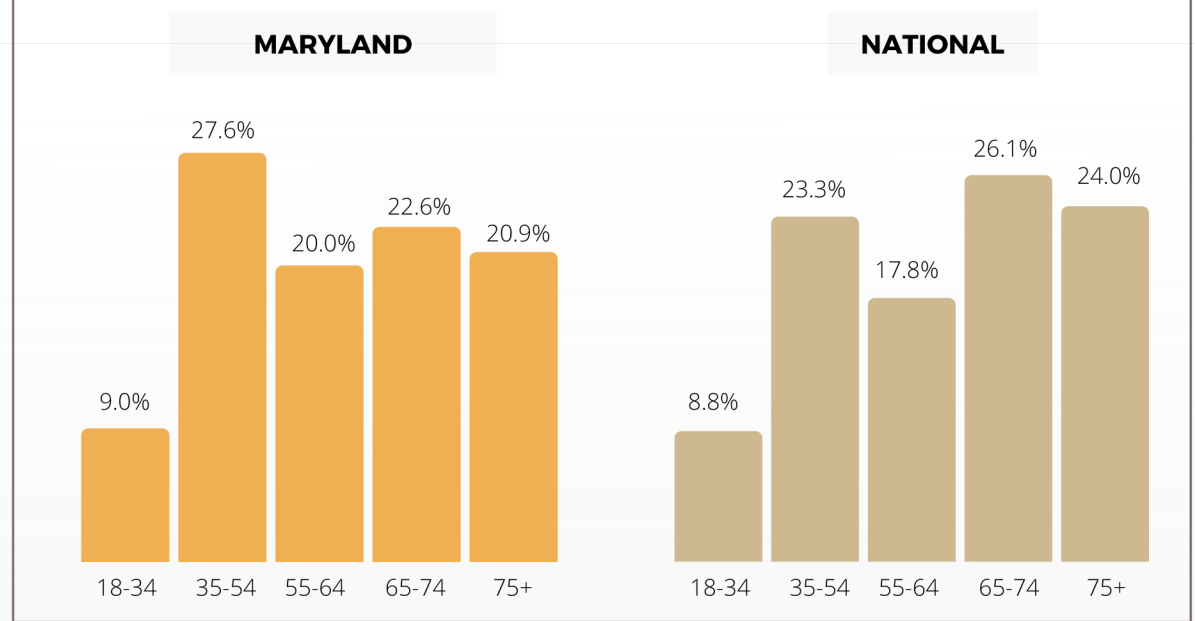

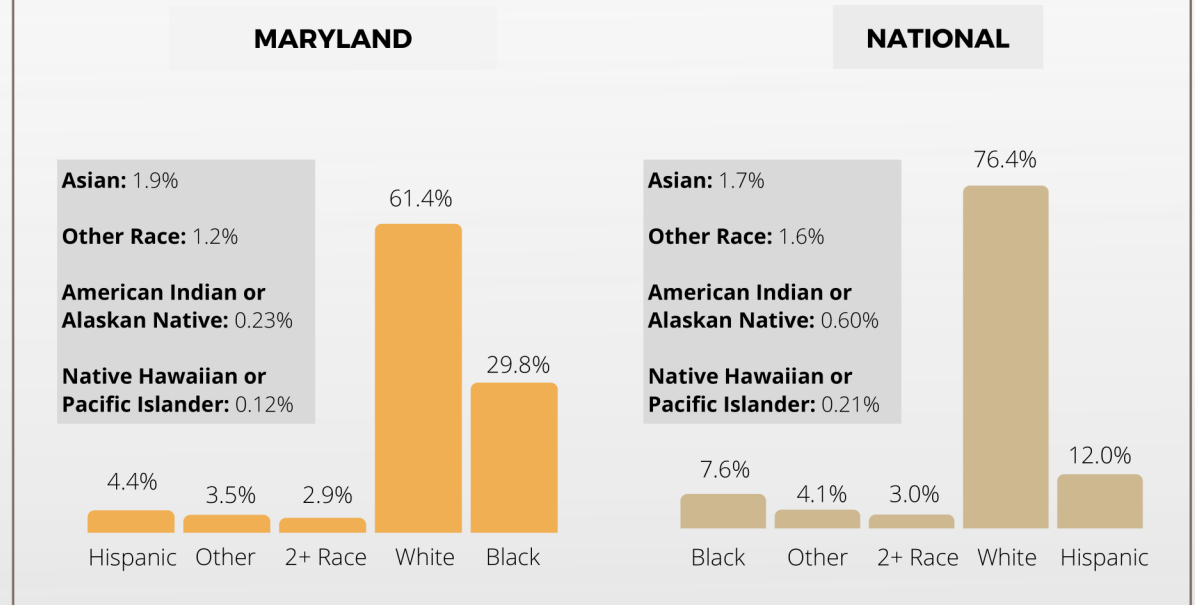

VETERAN POPULATION BY AGE

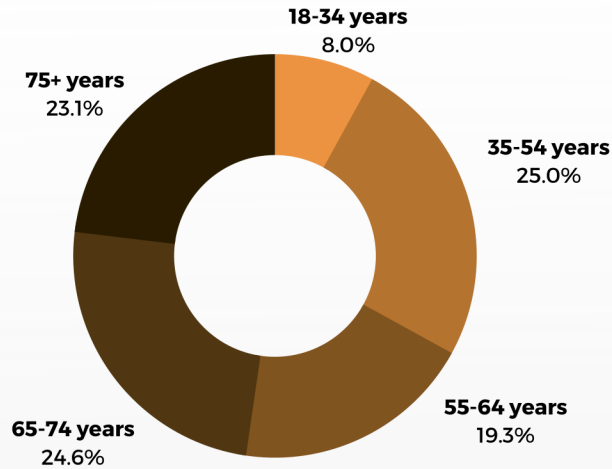


VETERAN POPULATION BY RACE

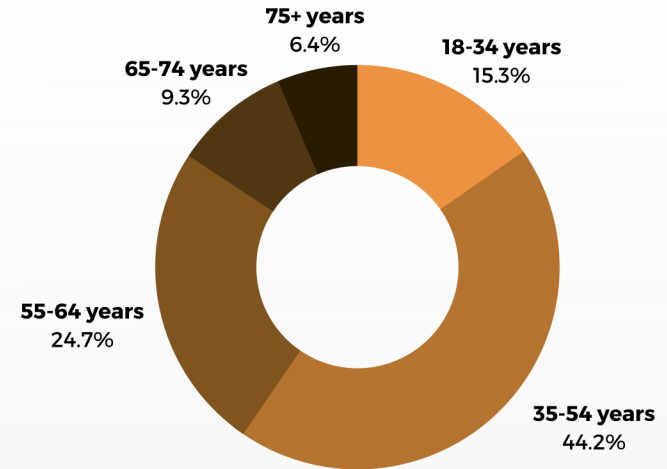

MALE VETERANS BY AGE

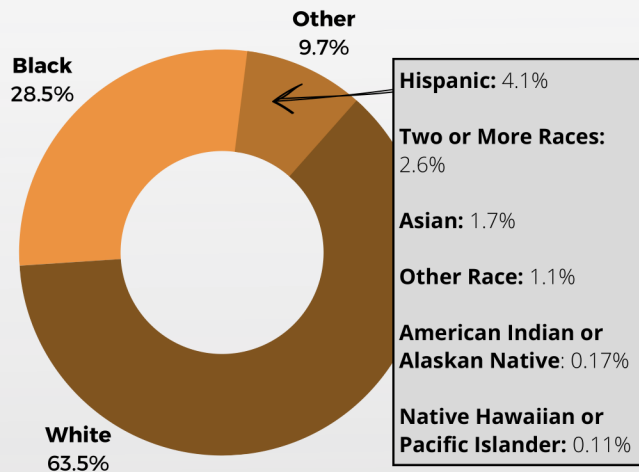


FEMALE VETERANS BY AGE

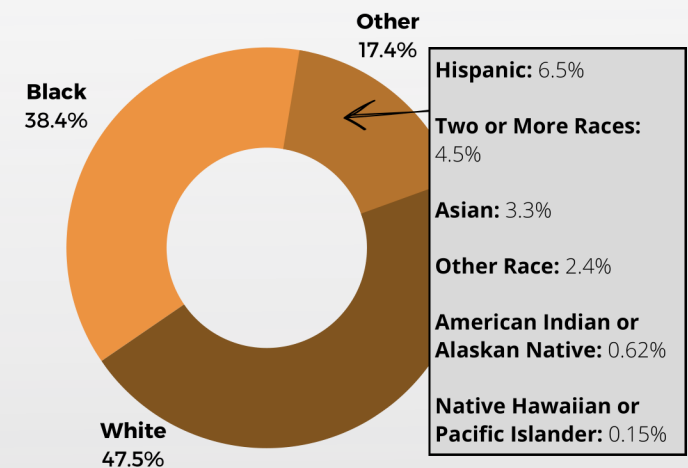


Approximately **310,000 male veterans** live in Maryland.

Approximately **47,000 female veterans** live in Maryland.

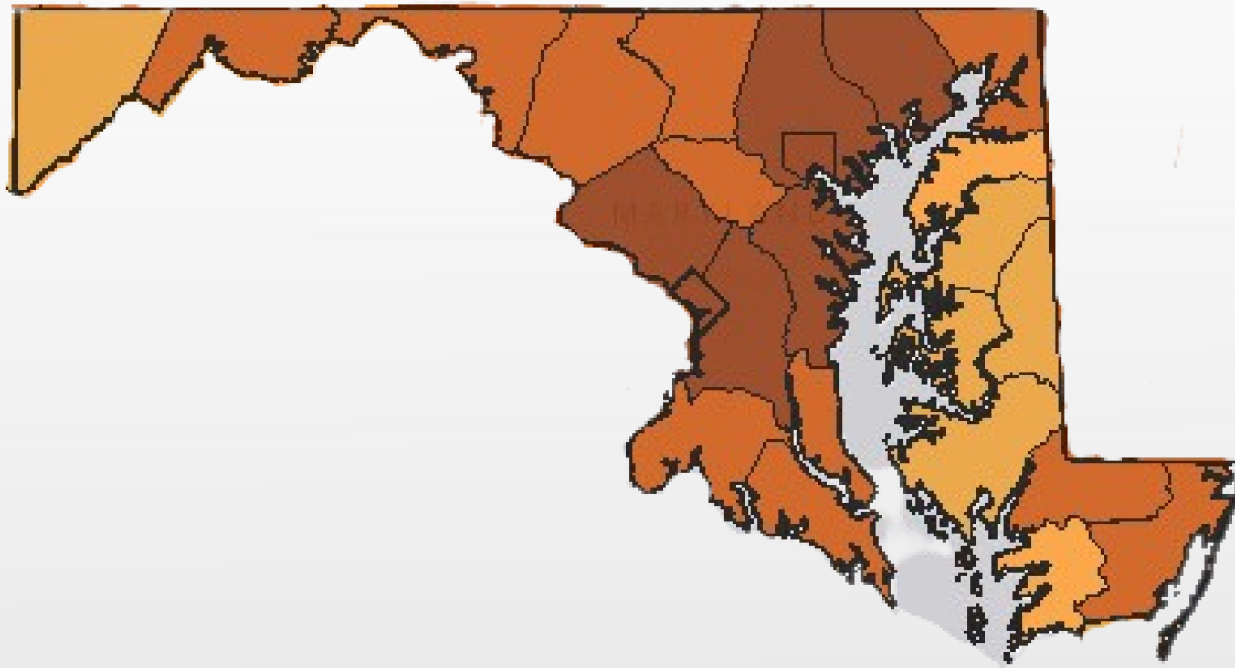

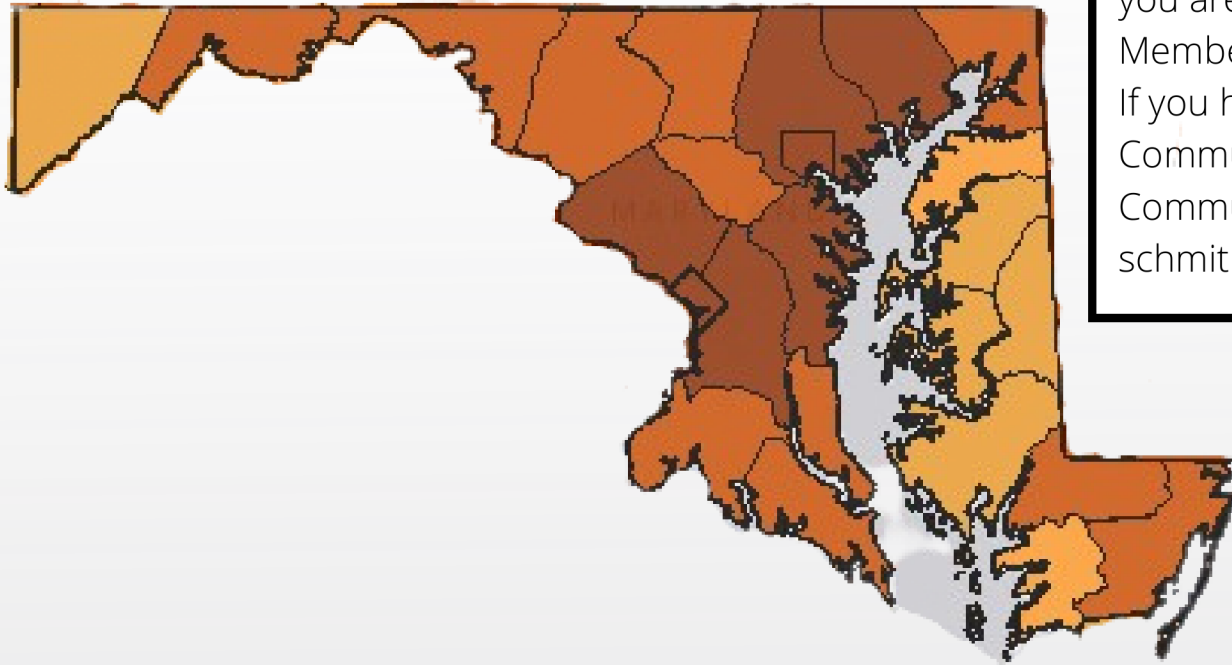
