- Reordering is easy and free

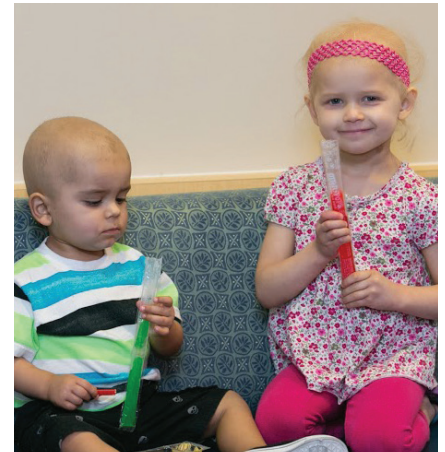

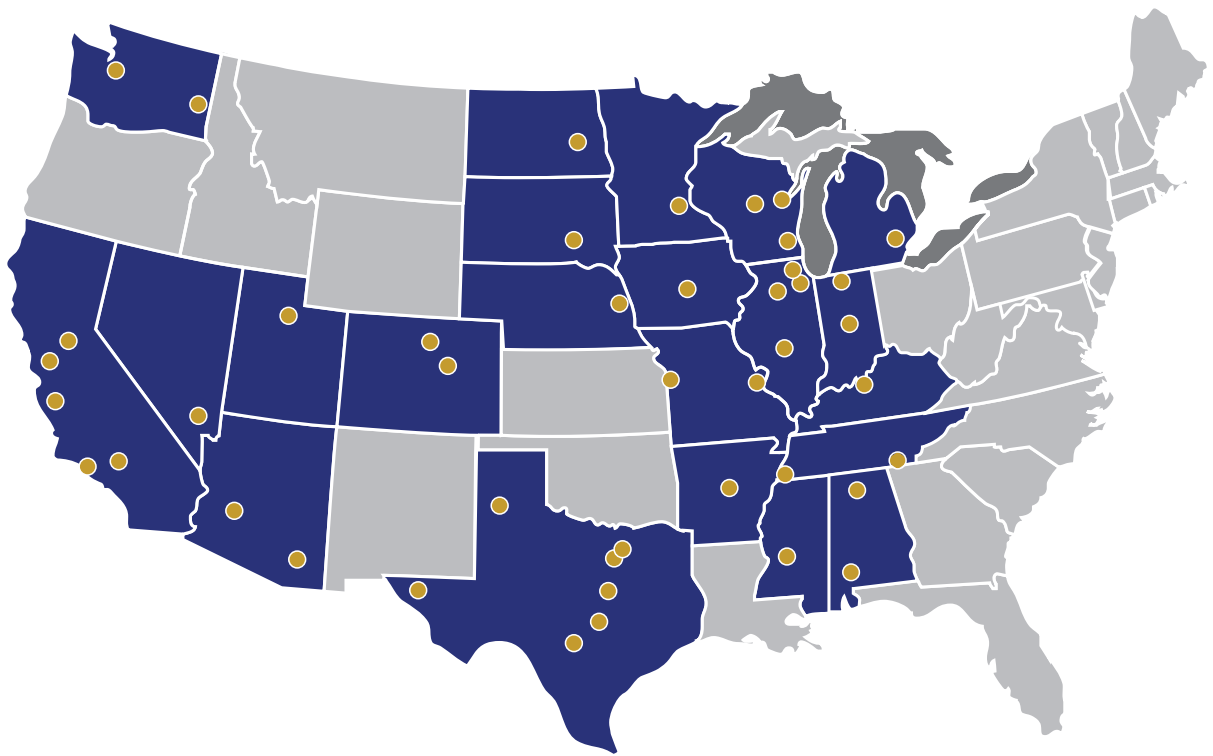

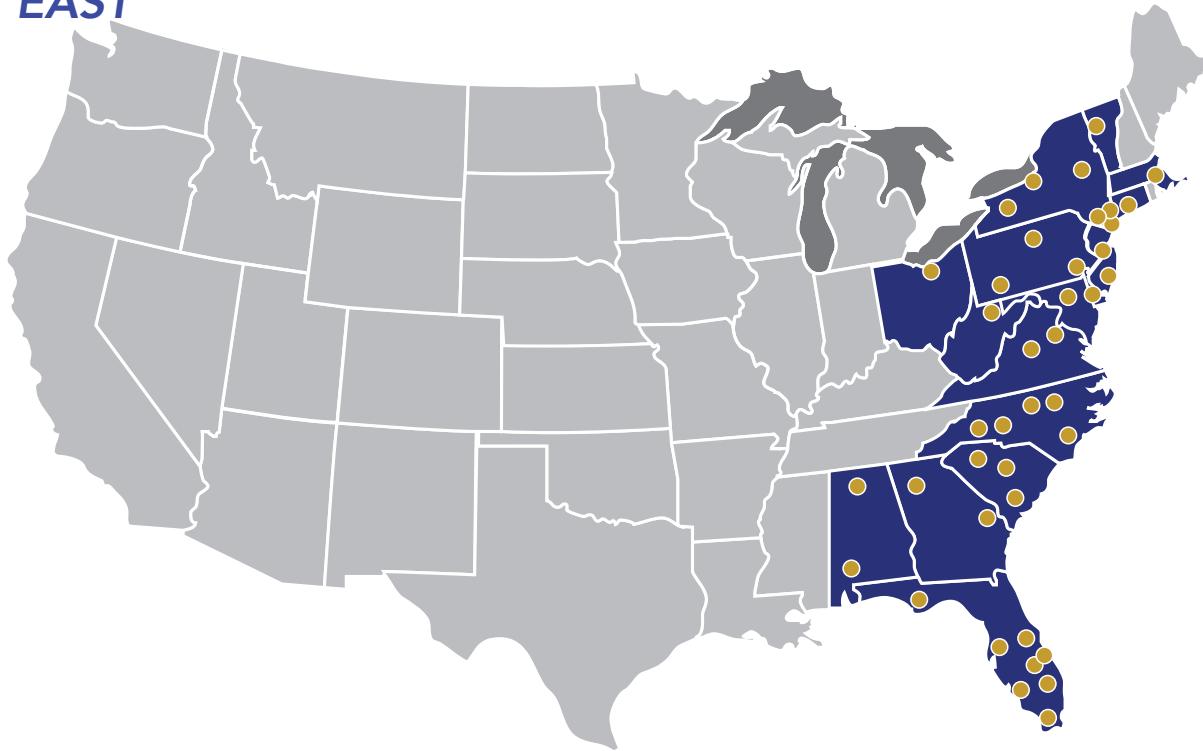
