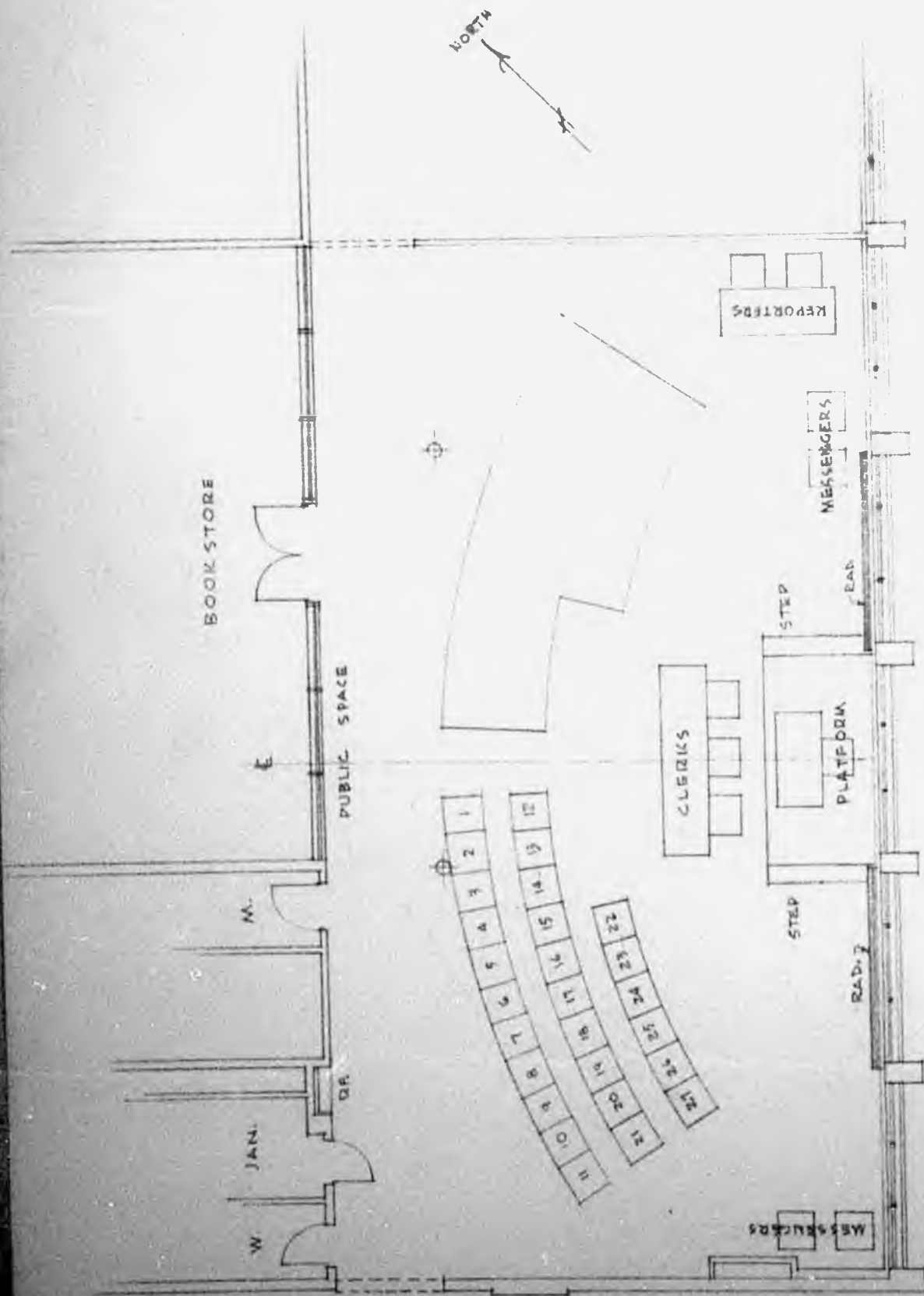

CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION

College, Alaska, November 8, 1955 - Opening Ceremony

GOVERNOR: The hour appointed by the Alaska Territorial Legislature having arrived for the convening of the Alaska Constitutional Convention, I do accordingly, as governor of this Territory, call the Convention to order.

It is appropriate that those to whom so much has been entrusted by our voters call upon God for guidance at the outset of their task. It is my privilege at this time to present the Rev. Roy Ahmaogak of Wainwright, Alaska, who will offer an invocatory prayer:

REV. AHMAOGAK: (Prayer)

GOVERNOR: Pursuant to the authority vested in me as Governor of the Territory of Alaska, I do hereby appoint John B. Hall to act as temporary Secretary of this Convention until the delegates are sworn in and officers can be elected by the Convention.

Will the Secretary please read the certificate of the results of the Special Election to elect delegates to the Constitutional Convention.

SECRETARY: (Reads certificate of Secretary of Alaska Waino E. Hendrickson)

GOVERNOR: The temporary Secretary will call the roll of delegates.

Will the delegates please answer by saying "present."

SECRETARY: (Calls roll of Delegates)

GOVERNOR: I declare a quorum of the elected delegates present. Will the delegates now stand and be sworn by the Honorable Vernon D. Forbes, United States District Judge for the Fourth Judicial Division, Alaska.

JUDGE FORBES: (Swears delegates)

GOVERNOR: Will each of the delegates now kindly sign the oath of office which is on your desks, and deliver these forms to the temporary Secretary.

(After forms have been signed and delivered to Secretary, call to order and inquire whether each of the Delegates has signed and delivered the form)

GOVERNOR: (Following address and welcoming addresses)

Ladies and gentlemen of the Convention. Under the procedure established by Section 13 of Chapter 46, Session Laws of Alaska 1955, the Governor of Alaska to preside over the Constitutional Convention until temporary officers are elected. I believe the time has now arrived for the election of temporary officers and I now call for nominations for the office of Secretary Pro Tem of the Convention.

(A Secretary Pro Tem having been elected, the Secretary Pro Tem is requested to record the further actions of the Convention)

I now call for nominations for the office of Temporary President of the Constitutional Convention. It is my understanding that you may wish to adopt certain rules, or temporary rules, before electing permanent officers. The procedures following the election of the Temporary President will, however, be conducted under his guidance and in accordance with the wishes of a majority of the delegates present.

(Nomination and election of Temporary President)

GOVERNOR: Mr. _____ has by your vote been elected Temporary President of the Alaska Constitutional Convention. I will appoint Mr. E. B. Collins, Mr. R. R. Armstrong and Mr. W. W. Laws to escort the Temporary President to the chair.

Mr. _____, I wish to congratulate you upon your election to the office of Temporary President of this Convention. It gives me great pleasure to hand you this gavel and to turn over to you the further conduct of the proceedings.

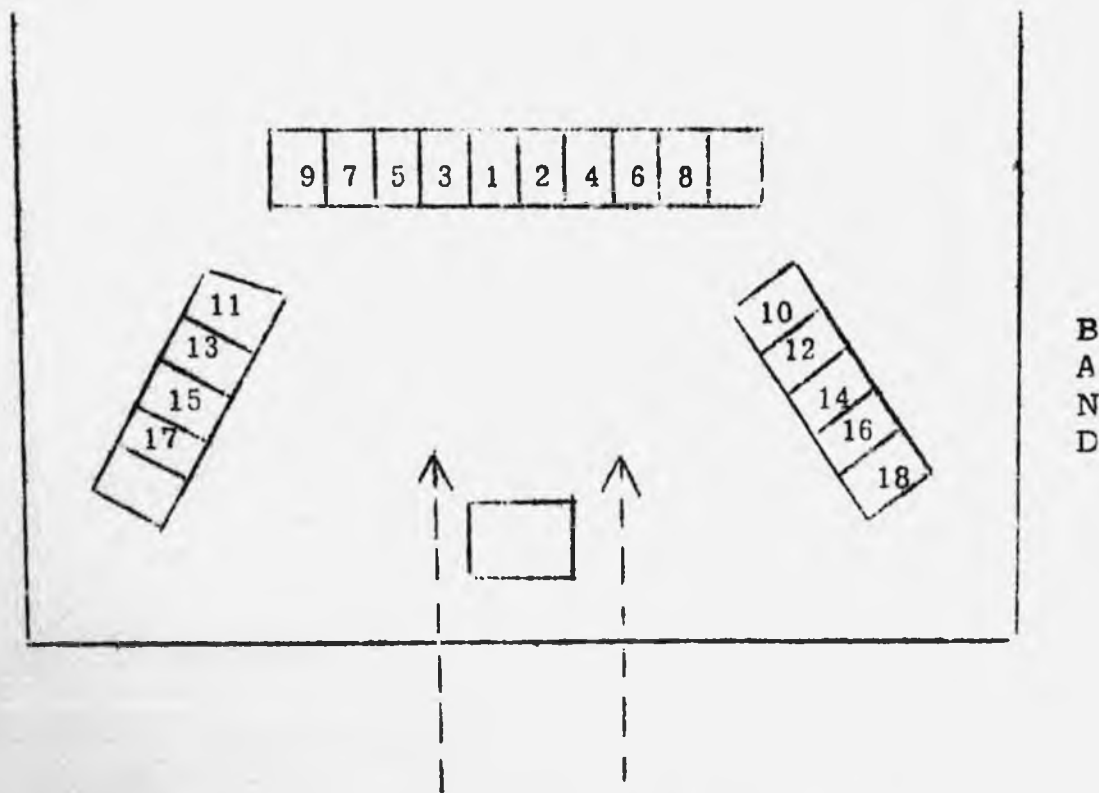

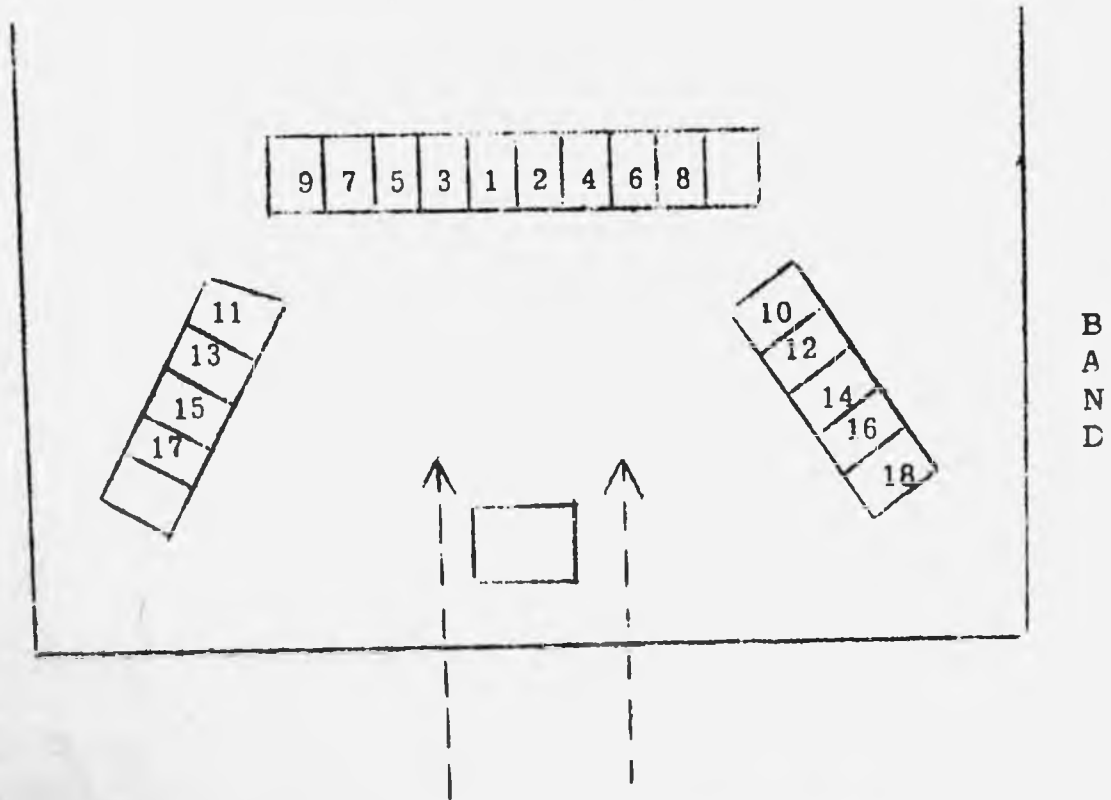
