Canvass Minutes

January 10, 2024; 9:30am

Chairman Powers called the January 10, 2024, meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. Present were two members of the Alexandria Electoral Board (Jack Powers and Tom Fulton); the General Registrar (Angie Maniglia Turner); the Elections Manager (Mark Hirschman); and the Assistant Elections Manager (Tony Berardo).

The Electoral Board turned over Envelope 2s to the Elections Manager and Assistant Elections Manager to open and begin organizing in preparation of the review of Statements of Results.

Provisional Ballot Hearing

No members of the public were present for the provisional ballot hearing. The board agreed that if any voter arrived, they would move to reopen the hearing.

The board confirmed that there were 13 provisional ballots and referred them to staff for research.

Review of Statements of Results

The board reviewed the Statement of Results and Incident Reports from each precinct. Upon completion, the board turned over the paperwork to the ascertainment team.

At 11:02 a.m., Mr. Fulton moved to recess the Board meeting until January 12, 2024 at 11:00 a.m., Mr. Powers seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Reconvening of Canvass

On January 12, 2024 at 10:56 a.m. acting chairman Fulton called the Canvass back into session. Present were two members of the Alexandria Electoral Board (Bruce A. Brown and Tom Fulton); the General Registrar (Angie Maniglia Turner); the Elections Manager (Mark Hirschman); and the Assistant Elections Manager (Tony Berardo).

Mr. Brown made a motion to relieve the acting secretary, Mr. Fulton, from the duties of secretary given the return of the secretary of the board, and that the vice chair should assume the duties of acting chair until the return of the chair. Mr. Fulton seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Provisional Precinct

At 12:00 p.m. the Electoral Board began considering whether each person who submitted a provisional vote at the election was qualified to do so. Other than appropriate staff of the Electoral Board, attendance at this meeting shall be permitted for the persons whose provisional votes were being considered with their legal counsel, if present, as well as one

authorized representative of each political party or independent candidate, as specified in §24.2-653.01(B). No voters who cast a provisional ballot or representatives of a political party or candidate were present.

Mr. Fulton made a motion to accept and count 4 same day registration provisional ballots. Mr. Brown seconded the motion and it passed unanimously. Mr. Fulton made a motion to accept and count 9 absentee provisional ballots. Mr. Brown seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

Post-Election Absentee Processing

The board reviewed the Statement of Results and Incident Report from the post-election absentee processing.

Abstract of Votes


After the provisional ballots were counted, the results from the provisional precinct were included in the election results. The abstract of votes was signed by the members of the Electoral Board, and the General Registrar was directed to forward documentation to the Virginia Department of Elections.
