Application - City of Alexandria, VA - Arts 275th Commemorative Program Grant

The Arts 275th Commemorative Program Grant is funded through a National Endowment for the Arts and the City of Alexandria, VA. The Commemorative Program Grant is available to eligible nonprofit organizations to create art programs and events that may honor the past through artistic historical reflections or commissions, embrace the now with thought-provoking art projects mirroring neighborhoods' culture, and celebrate the city's future with innovative art projects.

The programs will be representational of the city's demographics and neighborhoods who reflect low income, underserved, and immigrant populations. Nonprofit organizations will engage artists for a variety of projects such as neighborhood celebrations, ethnic and culturally centric creative expressions, youth or intergenerational arts programs, temporary artisans' markets, concert series, theatre or dance performances, visual arts demonstrations, or storytelling.

The Grant period is July 1, 2024, through December 31, 2024. Grants will range from \$1,000 - \$5,000 per award and will not have a cash match requirement.

Online applications must be submitted by 5:00 p.m. Friday, June 21, 2024. Funding decisions will occur by Friday, June 28, 2024.

Eligibility Requirements

- Nonprofit 501(c) 3 organizations who are in good standing with the IRS; and fiscal agents and pass-through funding WILL NOT be permitted.
- Must have their IRS letter of determination for at least one year before applying and must stay in existence during the grant period.
- Must NOT have defaulted on any past grant applications.
- May apply for ONLY one Arts 275th Commemorative Grant.
- Arts programs, projects and activities previously awarded by the City by other City grant programs are NOT eligible.
- NO physical alterations or physical additions to properties.
- NO permanent hardware will be necessary.
- Neither temporary nor permanent art installations are included in grant activities.
- City agencies, employees, or volunteers (defined as any agency under the direct control of

an elected official, or which reports directly to the City Manager), MAY NOT apply for the Arts 275th Commemorative Program Grant; they may only play a supportive role in a program proposed by an organization or group.

- The programs will need to occur in a pre-approved locations.
- Must have a signed "Location Agreement."
- Follow all local, state, and federal laws.

Evaluation Criteria:

Applicants need to demonstrate:

- Artistic Excellence (45%).
- Artistic Merit which is represented by: Impact and Engagement (35%); and Management and Budget (20%).

Application will be reviewed and evaluated on its own merit based on the following criteria:

- is fully eligible to apply and receive the funds.
- intends to remain in operation to receive the funds and utilize funds as indicated.
- and is in good standing with the City of Alexandria.
