PROCLAMATION

**NATIONAL DRUNK, DRUGGED DRIVING PREVENTION MONTH
DECEMBER 2023**

WHEREAS, the National Impaired Driving Prevention Month, or the National Drunk and Drugged Driving (3D) Prevention Month, is an annual designation observed in the month of December;

WHEREAS, if you have been drinking or are under the influence of drugs, do not operate a vehicle. Remember, you are committing the crime of impaired driving whenever your ability to operate a vehicle is impaired by effects of illegal drugs, prescription medication, over-the-counter medication, or a blood-alcohol concentration of 0.08 grams per deciliter or higher;

WHEREAS, in American Samoa the number of Driving-Under-the-Influence is steadily decreasing from 184 arrested for drunk driving in 2018 to 101 arrested for drunk driving in 2022, and this may be attributed to the annual reminders for friends and family to drive responsibly. By educating and setting a good example we can begin to turn the tide of impaired driving, and focus on the connectedness and joy that this time of year should truly be about;

WHEREAS, the following tips should be observed through this season and throughout the year:

- Always **plan ahead**. Designate a sober driver and arrange for an alternative route home just in case.
- If you are a parent, grandparent, aunt, uncle, or even friend. Talk to your loved ones to **remind them how important it is to be responsible and stay safe**.
- If you are the one hosting the party, always offer a **non-alcoholic option** for drinks for your guests so they can still have a good time eating and drinking with everyone else!

WHEREAS, public and private organizations from our territory are joining the Department of Health and the Department of Public Safety in promoting the National Drunk, Drugged Driving Prevention Month 2018 under the theme: "Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over" this December by supporting anti-impaired driving program and policies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Lemanu P. S. Mauga do hereby proclaim December 2023, as National Impaired Driving Prevention Month in American Samoa and hereby call upon all citizens, government agencies, business leaders, hospitals, schools, and public and private institutions in American Samoa to promote awareness of the impaired driving problem, to support programs and policies to reduce the incidence of impaired driving, to promote safer and healthier behaviors regarding the use of alcohol and other drugs,


