PROCLAMATION

**"DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH (DVAM)
OCTOBER 2023"**

"EVERY1 KNOWS SOME1"

WHEREAS, Domestic violence is a pattern of behaviors used by one partner to maintain power and control over another partner in an intimate relationship. It can happen to anyone at any point in a relationship. Domestic violence includes behaviors that physically harm, cause fear, prevent a partner from doing what they wish, or force them to behave in ways they do not want; and

WHEREAS, Over 51% of Samoa women 15-49 years old reported experiencing physical violence from their husbands or someone else since the age of 15, 1 in 3 married women of the same age group reported experiencing physical, sexual & emotional violence by an intimate partner, 2 in 5 women aged between 15-49 years has experienced physical violence committed by non-partners since the age of 15, and 16% of them experienced it in the last 12 months, while 1 in 5 women aged between 15-49 years old reported experiencing any sexual violence committed by any perpetrator in their lifetime, 1 in 10 experienced it in the last 12 months, women ages of 20-24 are more likely to experience emotional, physical or sexual violence by an intimate partner, of the pregnant Samoa women between ages 15-49, 4.6% reported experiencing physical violence during pregnancy. Of all the women who had experienced physical, emotional and or sexual violence, only 40% of those had reported the matter; and

WHEREAS, there is a continuous need to provide education, awareness and understanding of domestic violence and its causes; Recognizing the need to understand the complexity of violence as perpetuated within communities and against communities, and the fear of many survivors to report to law enforcement; and

WHEREAS, we can all help build and maintain a cultural framework that addresses family violence, where abuse is not tolerated and where survivors are heard, supported, and protected. We must remain committed to building a better American Samoa where all can feel safe, respected, live free from abuse and embrace healing. We must let go of the mindset that "Violence is part of our Samoan Culture" and never forget the faaSamoa is founded on love and respect, centers on family, and restores communities; and

WHEREAS, Every1 knows Some1 campaign strives to highlight how common domestic violence is and that it is more than physical violence. It means that everyone knows someone who has been affected by domestic violence, whether you can see it or not. One isn't just a number, it's SOMEONE – a family member, a neighbor, a coworker, a friend. Domestic violence affects all of us, and all of us must be part of the solution. Getting involved in DVAM is a great way to stand up for survivors, while raising awareness and starting a conversation about preventing domestic violence in American Samoa.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TALAUEGA E. V. ALE, Acting Governor of the Territory of American Samoa, do hereby proclaim October 2023, as "Domestic Violence Awareness Month" and endorse the commitment to ending Domestic Violence in the community. I call on all citizens of American Samoa to speak out and stand up against domestic violence. I call on American Samoa to support efforts to educate young people about healthy relationships centered on respect. I call on American Samoa to support victims and survivors in your own families and networks. I call on American Samoa to support efforts of all service providers working to support victims of violence. I call on American Samoa to end domestic violence and return our nation to ways of our faasamoa of respect, honor, love and compassion.
