O le pitolaau o a'oa'oga o se tasi o vaega e aupito itiiti totogi ma e lē tele so latou faatauaina i galuega faaporofesa i ona aso nei. Ae peita'i, e tumau pea faiaoga i le galuega ona e ulufale atu ma taga'i i foliga o a taeao – i latou e atiina'eina o tatou aiga ma fanau i le lumana'i, loia, foma'i, faiaoga, ta'ita'i o lo tatou Teritori. E le na'o le a'oa'o atu le tiute o faia'oga; latou te faa'auupega tamaiti e tapena ai mo lo tatou soifuaga.

Fai mai le muāfetalaiga, “E tatala e faia'oga faitoto'a. O oe lava e te ulufale.” O le matafaioi a le faia'oga o le fesoasoani i a tatou fanau ia iloa le eseesega o faitoto'a ua avanoa mai mo latou ma avatu le loto tele e sāvali ai i luma.

E galulue filiga faia'oga e faatupu le naunau, faamalosi, ma lagolago a tatou fanau, ma e le fesiliglia lo latou sao i le faatupu malosi i o tatou aiga ma nuu. E suia e faiaoga soifuaga ma e le tatau ona faatauvaa se manatu i la latou galuega fita faaositaulaga. E ao ina tatou silasila ma le ootia ma le lagona faaaloalo i faiaoga.

E ui ina onomea le faafetai i faiaoga i vaiaso uma, a'o lenei lava Vaiaso o le Faatauaina o Faiaoga, se'i o tatou manatunatu i le sao ma le tuutoina o o latou tagata atoa, ma tatou taga'i ai i aafiaga lelei ma le aogā i a tatou fanau ma le lumana'i o le Teritori o faiaoga.

E fai a'u ma sui o le Afioaga i le Kovana Lutena ma o ma aiga e faafetai i faiaoga o Amerika Samoa, le malo ma aoga tuma'oti, i lo latou onosa'i, naunauta'i, ma le tuutoina ina ia mautinoa se manua o outou alo ma a matou fanau. Tatou faailogaina le auaunaga lē faavaivai e fausia mafaufau o outou alo ma a matou fanau mo le lumana'i.
