We respectfully request that you and the Committees of Reference review and consider the attached Sunrise Application for expansion of the scope of practice of Licensed Acupuncturists in Arizona. As Founder and President/CEO of one of Arizona's Acupuncture and Asian/Oriental Medicine colleges in the state, I had the opportunity to be a part of the original enabling legislation over twenty years ago and to witness the incredible growth and development of the field in Arizona and in the United States.

Pursuant to A.R.S. 32-3105, we submit this application, as well as associated supporting documentation demonstrating the clear need and benefits for the expansion of scope. What follows is an articulation of the depth to which Arizona has been instrumental in supporting the education and development of the Acupuncture Medicine profession.
