Today, I vetoed House Bill 2502. I have significant concerns about how this legislation will affect the economic well-being of Arizonans participating in the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP).

I also have strong concerns about how this measure will undermine our state's ongoing efforts to connect SNAP participants with high-quality training and job support services. The SNAP Career Advancement Network (SNAP CAN), which provides SNAP participants in Arizona with employment and training opportunities, is vital to strengthening our economy and moving our state forward, and I am proud of the progress made in this area. Instead of diverting our limited resources to lesser-quality supports, as is contemplated in this bill, I encourage you to join my Administration in expanding SNAP CAN's capacity and help all Arizonans reach their full potential.
