

House Ad Hoc Committee on Executive Oversight

PURPOSE: To (1) examine the scope and sufficiency of Arizona laws that establish the duties, powers, and proper role of the Arizona Attorney General and other state officers; (2) investigate allegations against state officers, including Arizona Attorney General Kris Mayes, that relate to abuse of statutory authority, refusal to perform duties required by law, and/or malfeasance in office; (3) identify, evaluate, and propose recommendations to the Arizona House of Representatives, including but not limited to: (a) potential legislation to promote the rule of law and deter partisan abuse and weaponization of the office of Arizona Attorney General or other state offices; and/or (b) any other appropriate remedial action authorized by the Arizona Constitution.
