

House Ad Hoc Study Committee on San Tan Valley Fire Coverage

PURPOSE: To solicit information and discuss issues surrounding fire coverage in San Tan Valley, Arizona. The Study Committee shall hear from stakeholders and residents on current challenges and limitations as well as proposed solutions to improve fire coverage in growing suburban areas which lack jurisdictional fire authority. The Study Committee shall publish a report of its findings on or before December 31, 2023.
