

Hydrogen Study Committee

PURPOSE: To investigate and evaluate existing state and federal laws, regulations and funding sources and recommend legislation related to the production, use, distribution and storage of hydrogen. On or before September 1, 2023, the Committee shall submit a report regarding the Committee's recommendations to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives and shall provide a copy of this report to the Secretary of State. The report must include an economic impact analysis of the potential hydrogen value chain in this State.
