

Peace Officer Training Equipment Fund Advisory Commission

PURPOSE: To make recommendations to the Legislature for fund allocations related to peace officer equipment. On or before December 1 of each year, the Commission shall submit written recommendations to the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Governor and the Chairs of the Senate Commerce and Public Safety Committee and the House of Representatives Judiciary and Public Safety Committee, or their successor committees and provide a copy of the recommendations to the Secretary of State.
