

Sexual Assault Kit Study Committee

PURPOSE: To examine the feasibility of providing crime victims with a tracking system for sexual assault forensic examination kits. On or before December 1, 2023, the Committee shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate and provide a copy of this report to the Secretary of State.

House Five members of the House of Representative, not more than three from the same political party and one designated as Chair, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives:

Other Two county sheriffs or their appointees, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives:

One Police Chief or the Police Chief's appointee, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives:
Vacant

One County Attorney or the County Attorney's appointee, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives:
Ms. Other Z-5

One representative of a group that represents victims' rights, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives:
Vacant
