## **Governor Signs Rep. Kolodin’s HB 2178 Combatting Anti-Semitism and Empowering Student Funding Decisions**

**STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX** – Arizona State Representative Alexander Kolodin announced that the Governor has today signed [HB 2178](#) into law. This bipartisan legislation grants public university students the authority to direct their tuition and fees away from student organizations and clubs that call for their genocide.

**“With the enactment of HB 2178, we’re upholding the cherished American values of freedom and personal choice,”** said Representative Kolodin. **“It respects the individual rights and choices of our public university students, ensuring that every student has the freedom to withhold support from organizations that do not align with their values and beliefs. It comes at an important time too, as Jewish students increasingly face harassment and discrimination on university campuses. This new law will help to make campuses welcoming for all students, irrespective of their backgrounds or beliefs.”**
