State Representative Michael Carbone's Bills to Address Arizona's Housing Crisis Signed into Law

STATE CAPITOL, PHOENIX – State Representative Michael Carbone released the following statement regarding the enactment of two bills he sponsored, [HB 2720](#) and [HB 2721](#), which aim to increase the supply of housing in the state of Arizona. Both bills passed the Legislature with strong bipartisan support.

“It’s the goal of Republicans in the Legislature to make life more affordable for everyday Arizonans by addressing the urgent need for more diverse housing options.

“I’m pleased to have the Governor sign my two bills into law, which will help mitigate the effects of rising housing costs and ensure that our teachers, nurses, firefighters, police officers, and families can live in the communities they serve and love. Importantly, the legislation reinforces a homeowner’s right to use their property as they see fit which, for some, may include adding accommodations for multigenerational housing or to generate additional income.

“The enactment of this legislation is a significant step toward solving the state’s housing crisis, and I am proud of the bipartisan effort that made it possible.”
