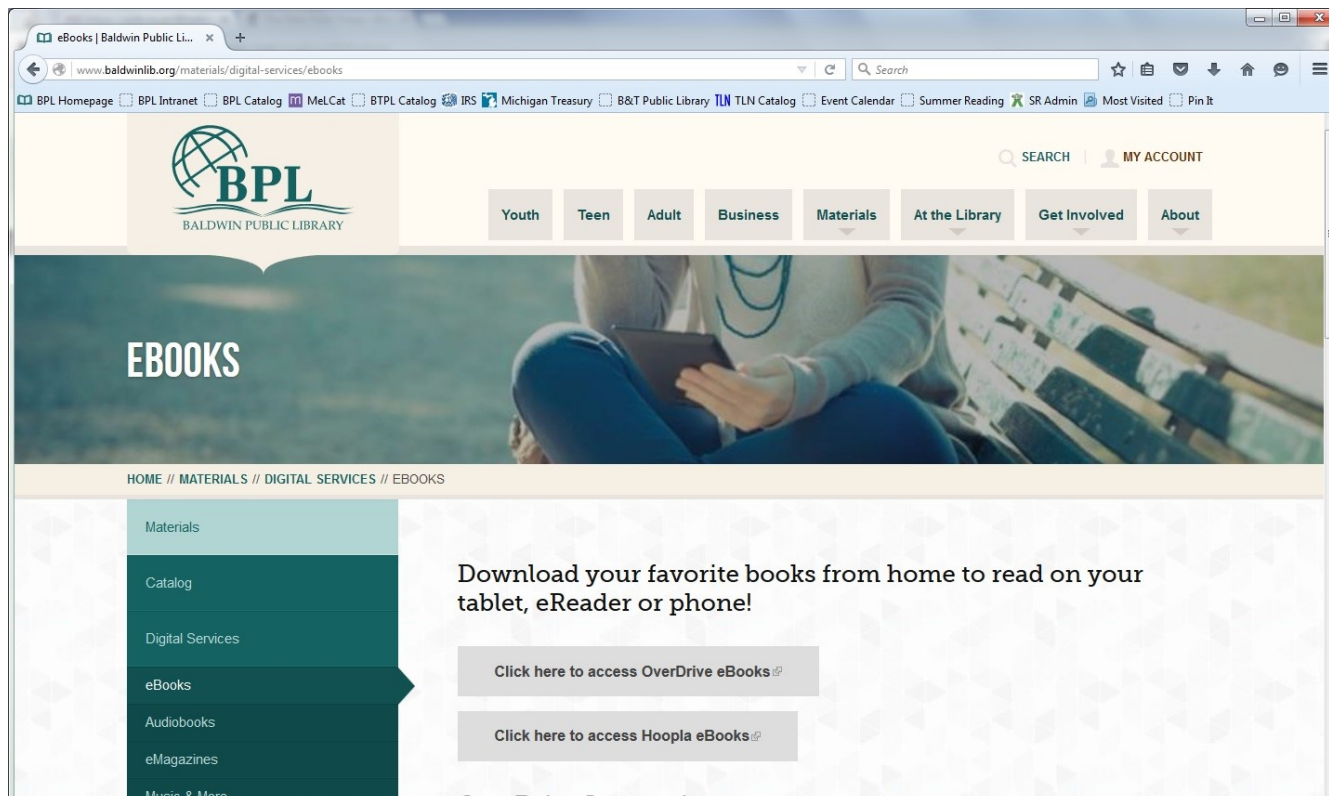


eBooks on Your Kindle

1. Navigate to <http://www.baldwinlib.org/ebooks> and click on the link “click here to access OverDrive eBooks”.




2. That will take you to the main OverDrive website. Click "Sign In" in the upper right hand corner.

4. Once you are logged in, you can search for books several different ways. Clicking on the search button (below, red arrow) will pull up a search box where you can search by title or author.


7. You will then see the gold banner below. Click the “Loans” link (red arrow, below) to proceed.

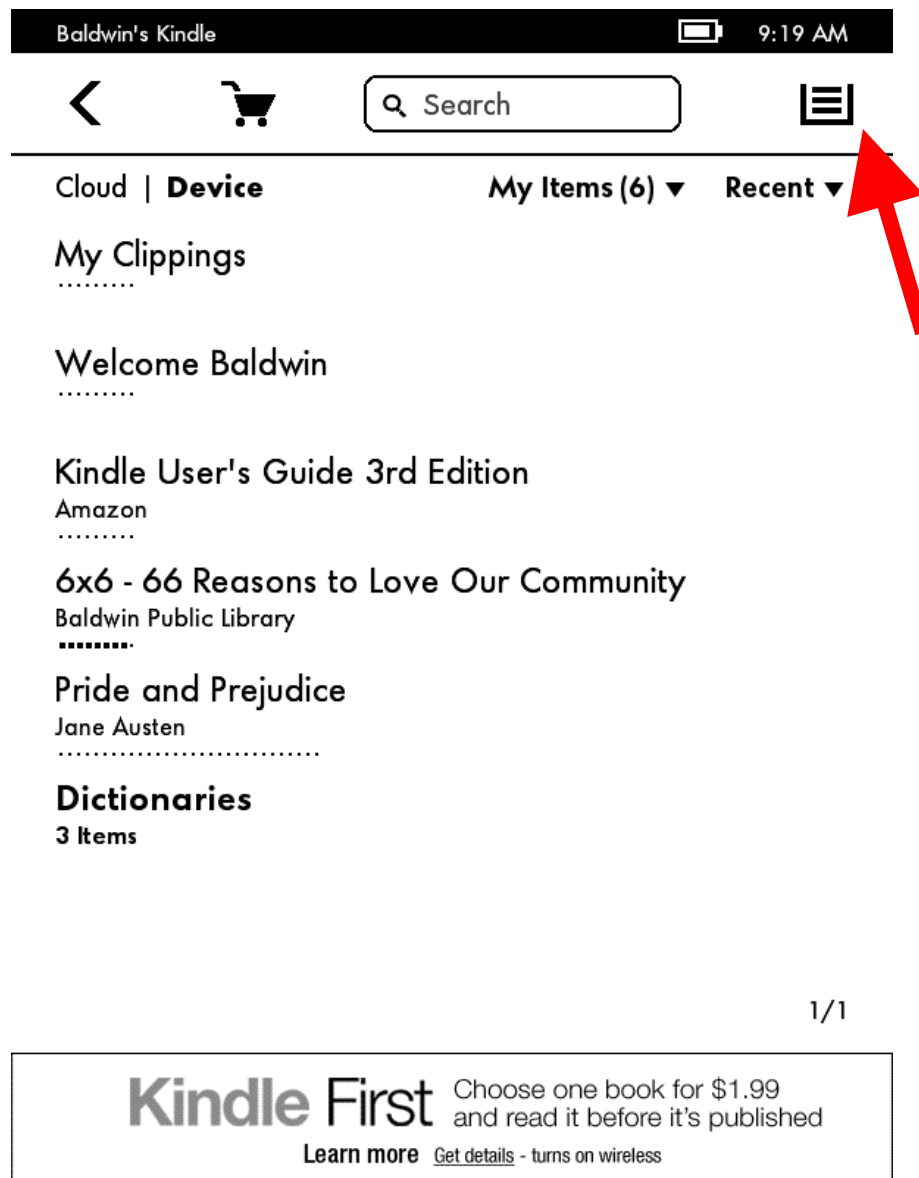

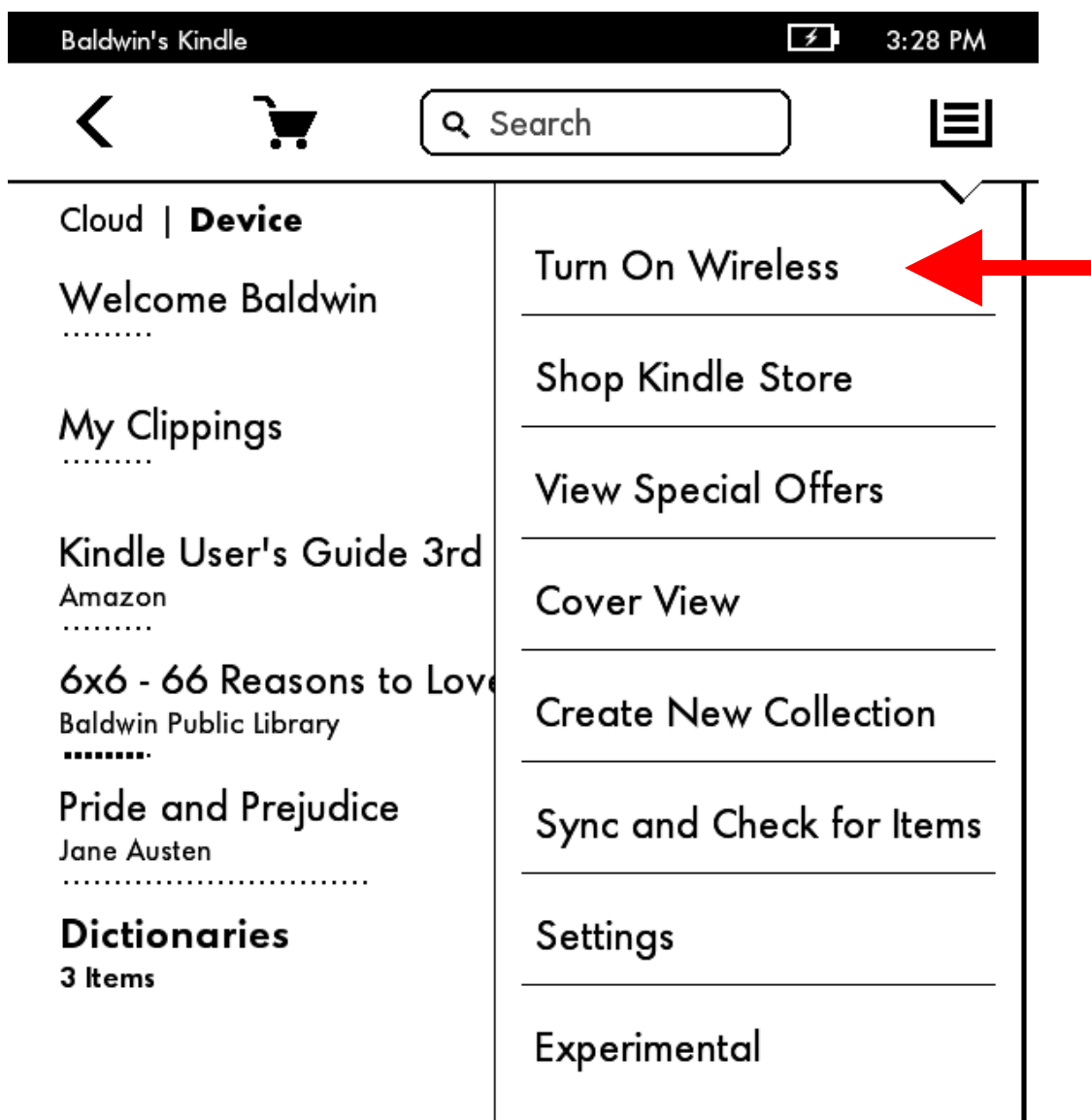
12. If your Kindle is not connected to a Wi-Fi network, you will need to connect to one. To do so, tap on the main menu icon to expand its options.* Note that library ebooks will not transfer over a 3G wireless network; you must connect to Wi-Fi.

Note that if you have a Kindle DX, you will need to transfer library titles to your device via USB.

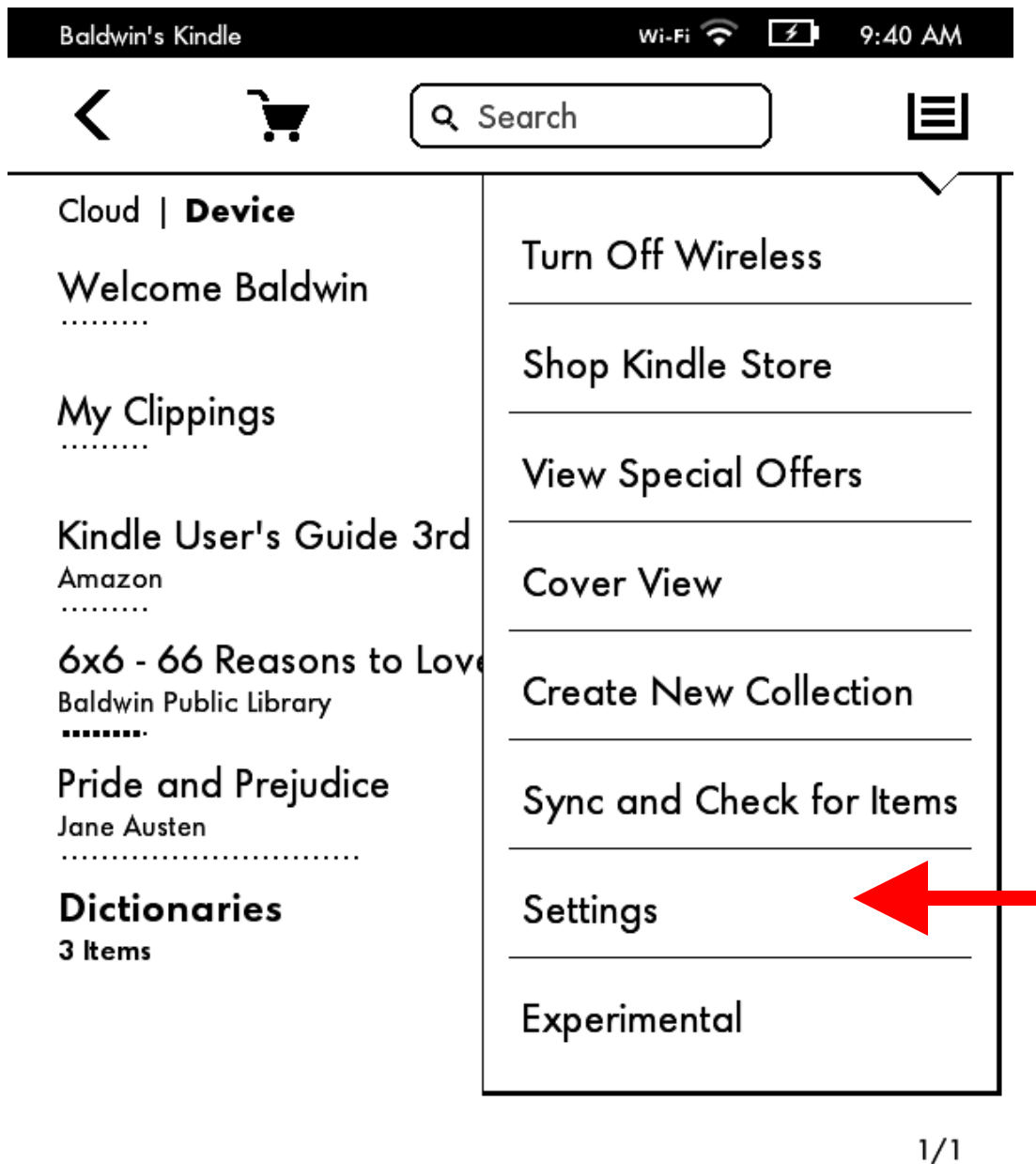
13. Select "Turn on wireless" from the menu.

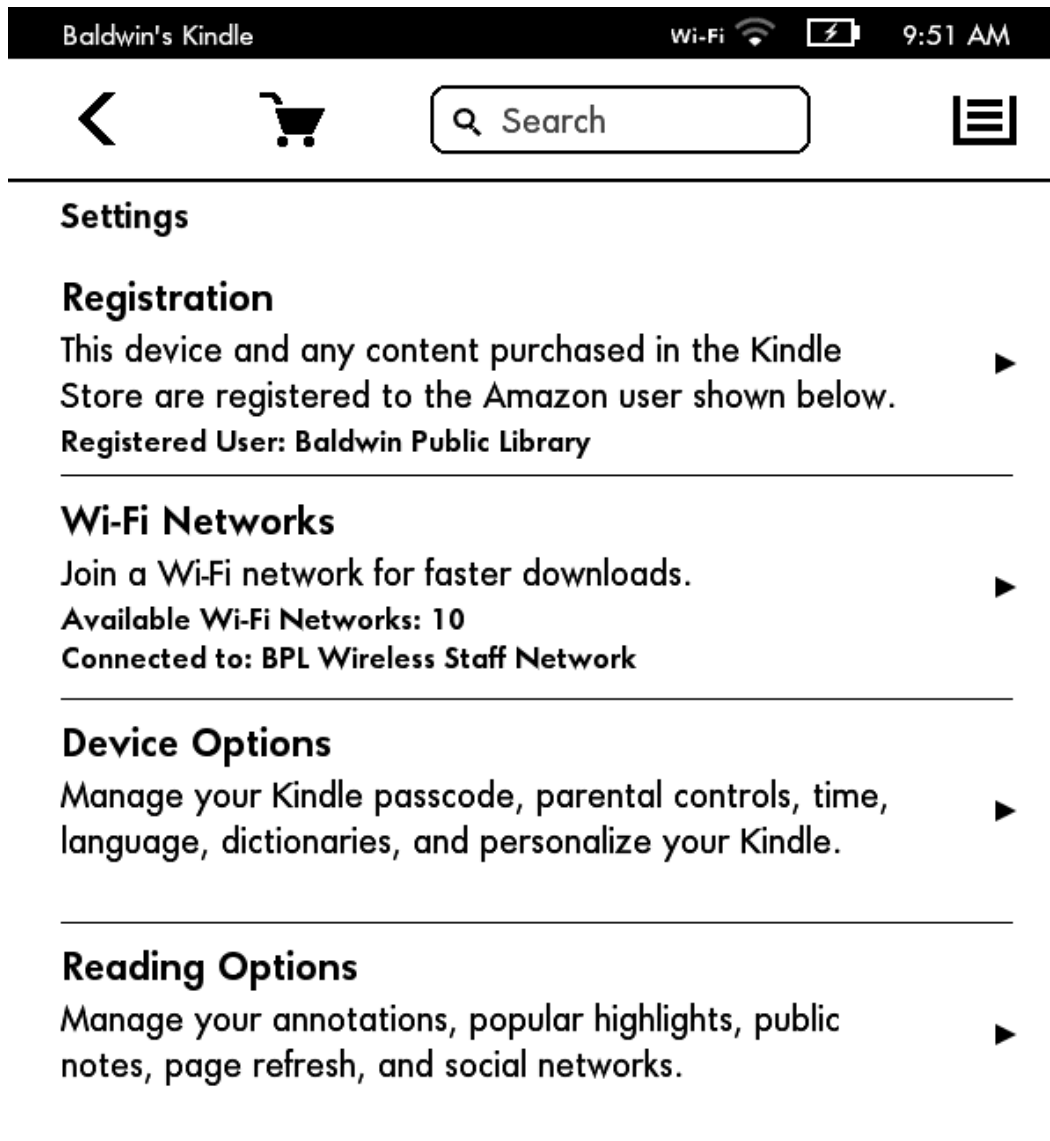

14. If you are not presented with a list of Wi-Fi networks to connect to, pull up the main menu again, and tap on “Settings”.

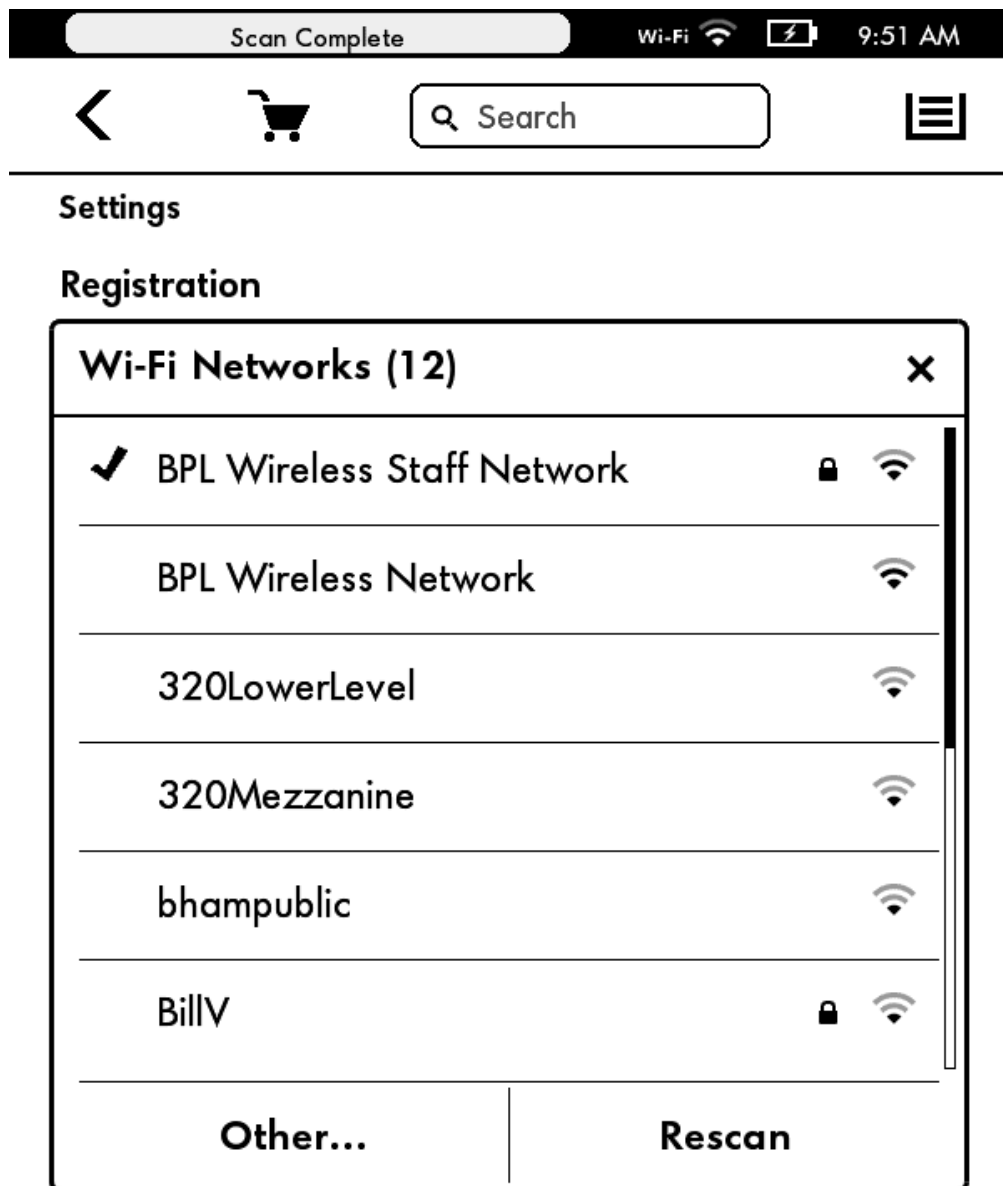

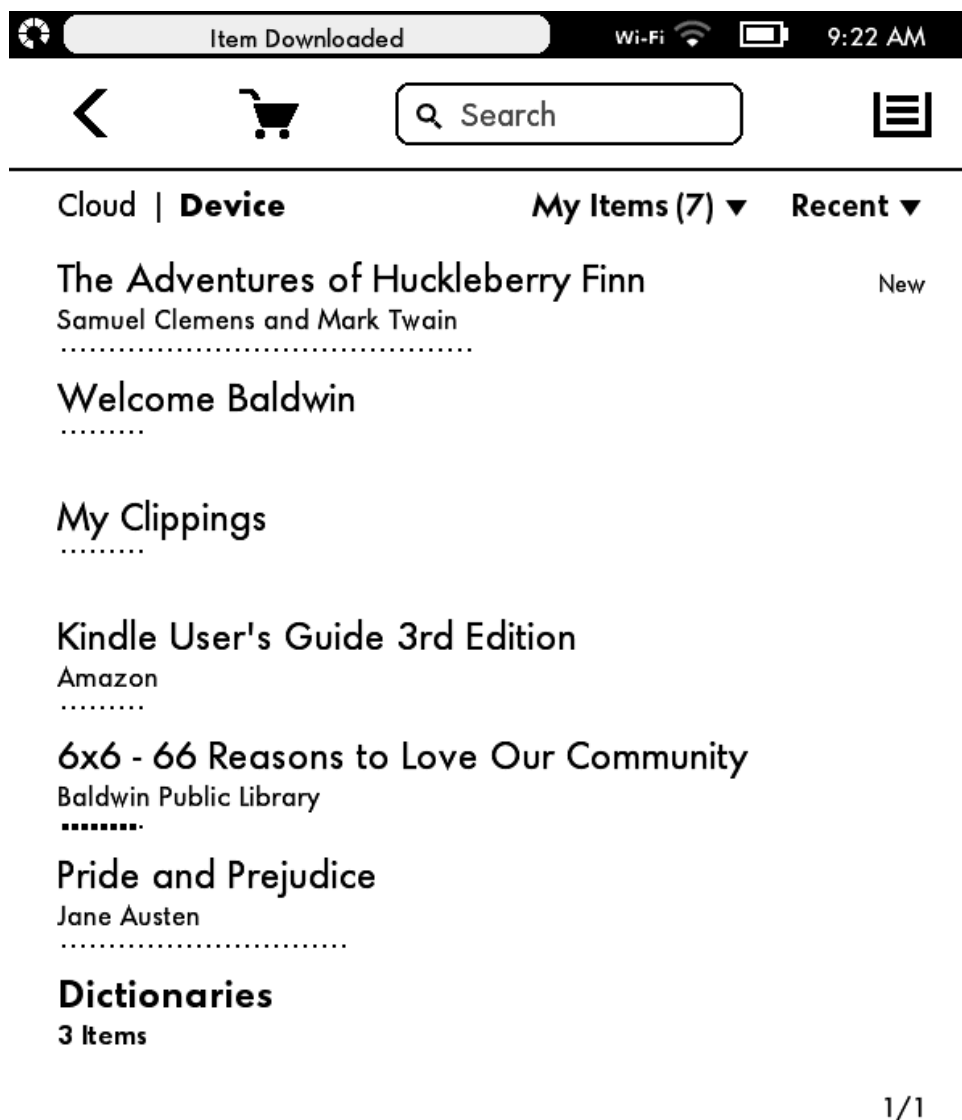
15. Then tap on “Wi-Fi Networks”.



16. You should then be presented with a list of nearby Wi-Fi networks to join. Tap the network you wish to connect to, and enter the password (if necessary).



17. Once you have connected to the network, you will see “Wi-Fi” in your top status bar, and your title should automatically begin to download, and will show up in your device library.
