On the above captioned date and time, the court considered its Order to Show Cause Why Sanctions Should Not Be Imposed Against Minh Nguyen-Duy State Bar No. 128125, For Failing To Comply With General Order 06-03 and Local Bankruptcy Rule 5005-4 (“OSC”) dated May 31, 2011. Appearances were stated on the record. Based upon findings of fact and conclusions of law stated on the record pursuant to F.R.Civ.P. 52(a)(1), as incorporated into FRBP 7052 and applied to contested matters by FRBP 9014(c), it is

ORDERED that Minh Nguyen-Duy State Bar No. 128125 (“Nguyen-Duy”) is suspended from practice before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of California pending (1) the issuance to Nguyen-Duy of a live ECF log-in and password in compliance with

1 LBR 5005-4; and (2) payment of the sum of \$800.00 in sanctions to the clerk of the court in
2 compensation for violation of LBR 5005-4 to the date of the OSC; and it is further

3 ORDERED that Nguyen-Duy must file an ex parte application for reinstatement,
4 supported by a declaration establishing compliance with the terms of this order, to terminate this
5 suspension and to resume practicing before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central
6 District of California. A proposed order granting reinstatement must be lodged with the court
7 upon the filing of the application for reinstatement.
