20 Sanctions Should Not Be Imposed Against Michael R. Perry, State Bar No. 193819, For Failing
21 To Comply With General Order 06-03 and Local Bankruptcy Rule 5005-4 (“OSC”) dated April
22 17, 2012. Appearances were stated on the record. Based upon findings of fact and conclusions

1 ORDERED that Perry must file an ex parte application for reinstatement, supported by a
2 declaration establishing compliance with the terms of this order, to terminate this suspension and
3 to resume practicing before the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Central District of
4 California. A proposed order granting reinstatement must be lodged with the court upon the
5 filing of the application for reinstatement.
