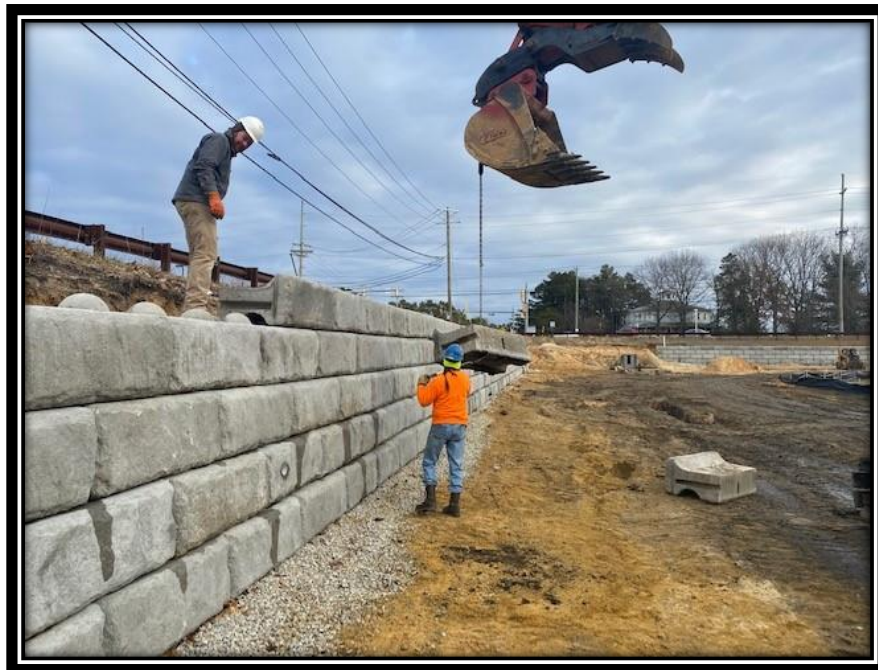


Figure 1: Contractor installing the REDI-ROCK cap block on the west retaining wall.

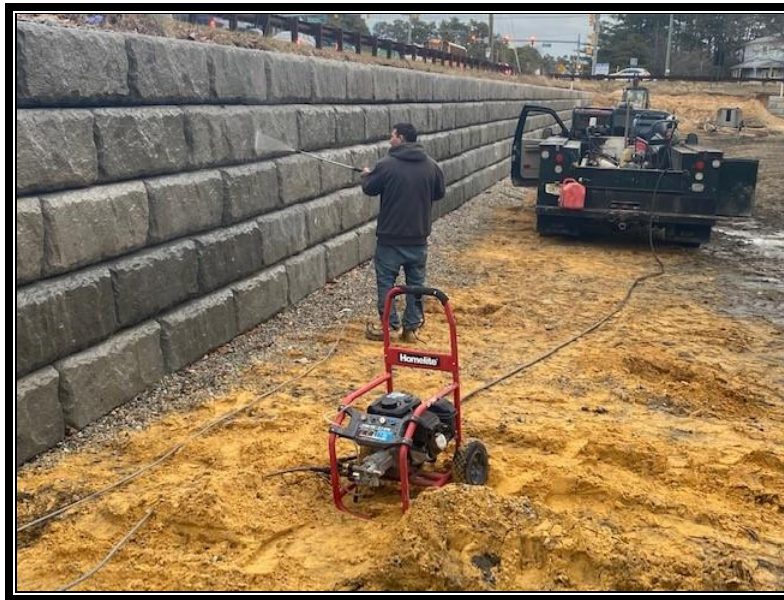


Figure 3: Contractor power-washing the REDI-ROCK retaining wall.

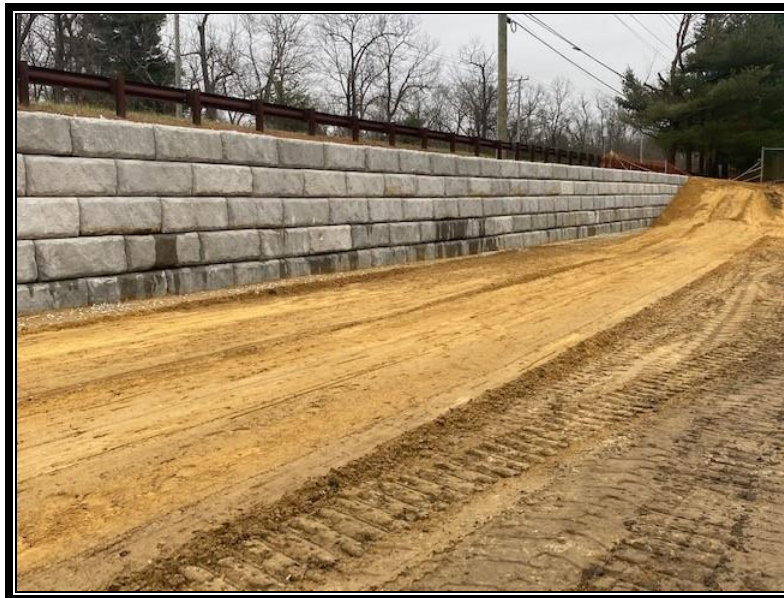


Figure 3: Contractor grading along the front of the REDI-ROCK retaining wall.

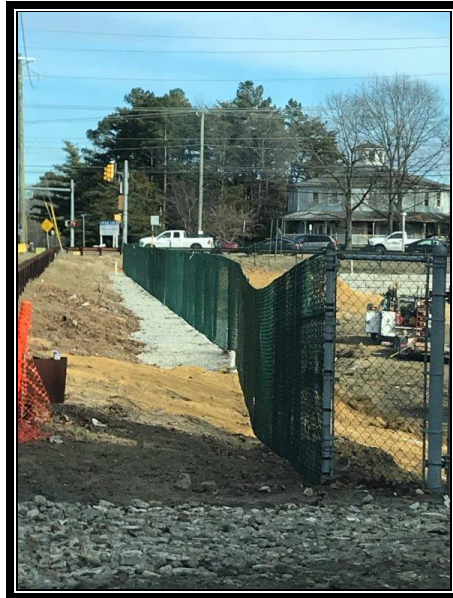


Figure 2: Road Safety Systems installing PVC coated chain-link fence along the west wall.
