Work Completed the Week of May 16, 2022:

A notice to proceed was issued to South State, Inc. to begin work on Monday, May 16, 2022. South State began work with the installation of soil erosion control measures and traffic control setup. South State's pipe crew mobilized to the site on Monday, May 16, 2022 and began installing storm sewer improvements along the eastbound lane between River Road and Sherman Lane. The pipe crew installed 27 linear feet of 15" RCP, 248 linear feet of 36" RCP, 1 type B-1 inlet, 1 type B-2 inlet, reset 1 existing inlet casting, 1 bicycle safe grate and 1 type "N" eco inlet head. All storm sewer work was completed between stations 1+44 and 4+03.

Work Completed the Week of May 23, 2022:

South State's pipe crew continued installing storm sewer improvements along the eastbound lane between River Road and Sherman Lane. The pipe crew installed 50 linear feet of 15" RCP, 8 linear feet of 24" RCP, 253 linear feet of 36" RCP and 3 type B-1 inlets. The pipe crew also excavated 75 cubic yards of unsuitable material and replaced it with I-14 fill. All storm sewer work was completed between stations 4+03to 6+62.

The pipe crew installed 55 linear feet of 15" RCP, 173 linear feet of 24" RCP, 3 type B inlets and 1 type double B inlet. All storm sewer work was completed between stations 9+76 to 10+91.
