Lost at Sea Memorial – Cannery Point Park

Also known as K'áaws Tláay. Look out towards the south end of Fish Egg Island and you can see where Haida Natives abandoned gardens, fish traps. Petroglyph and canoe runs are still visible.

The City of Craig was incorporated in 1922 as a second-class city under the laws of the Territory of Alaska. It became a first-class city in 1973. Named in 1907 after Craig Millar who established a fish saltery on nearby Fish Egg Island with the assistance of the Haida natives from the village of Klinkwan and Howkan.

 Before this was a ballpark, families had their garden here; The mound of dirt at the right-hand side of the gate at the cemetery trail used to be the dump.

Cemetery Trail
 ⤴ Moderate hike. Distance to walk trail head 1.8 miles round trip.

The Lagoon
 The Lagoon was a Haida summer camp with a longhouse and smoke house

Sunnahae Trail
 ⤴ Moderate hike. Forest Service. Distance to summit round trip 6.5 miles. Note: Weather can change quickly, use caution
