

COUNCIL MEETING HIGHLIGHTS

Registration History on Public Register

In March 2019, CRPO Council approved for 60-day public consultation a proposed by-law change that would publish a registrant's registration history on the public register. Upon further review of the public consultation results by staff and Executive, Council was presented with an alternate approach. The approach would involve keeping the registration history regarding non-payment of fees on the public register for a period of twelve months. After this period has passed and the registrant has remained in good standing, the registrant could file a request with CRPO to remove the past suspension notation from the public register.

Further details on the proposed changes and the opportunity to provide feedback will be posted to the website and communicated with registrants in the coming days.

Tariff Rate Increase
