Non-Council Member Appointment: Indigenous Pathways Panel

Council ratified the Executive Committee's recommendation to appoint Glenn Walsh, RP (Qualifying) to be a non-Council member of the Registration Committee for the Indigenous Pathways Registration Panel for a term of one year.

Election of Officers

The Vice-President was elected by Council in a recorded vote, with the positions of member at large (public and professional), being acclaimed. Nominations were sought from the floor to fill the remaining Member at large (public) vacancy. Two nominations were received, and an election was held. The next Executive Committee will take office on September 22, 2022.

2022 Fee Increase Deferral

Council approved the deferral of the planned June 2022 fee increase, noting that the College is in good financial health and is in a position to absorb the loss of revenue that the deferral represents. Bi-annual increases will recommence as per the by-laws in 2024.

2022-2023 Budget Revisions

Council approved budget increases to the following line items:

- Salaries, Benefits, HR
- Council & Committee Training
- Communications/Promotional
- Registrant Management Systems
- QA Program/Practice Advisory

The budget line-item increases will allow the College to continue to process core business in a timely manner and to move forward more quickly with several planned initiatives.

The revenue from increased applications will allow the College to add these costs and remain in the black for the fiscal year.
