Reconsideration Policy

Purpose

This policy sets out factors that may trigger a reconsideration by the Registration Committee or a Registration Committee panel.

Sources of Authority

Regulated Health Professions Act Code

Objects of College

3 (1) The College has the following objects:

2. To develop, establish and maintain standards of qualification for persons to be issued certificates of registration.

Scope

This policy applies to decisions made by the Registration Committee and/or Registration Committee panels.

Policy

A matter may be brought for reconsideration to the Registration Committee or a panel based on factors including, but not limited to:

- New information about the matter received from the concerned individual (e.g., applicant, registrant) or a third party
- New decisions that could have implications for the matter (e.g., Health Professions Appeal and Review Board decision)
- Advice from legal counsel or other third parties

Staff will determine whether a reconsideration is appropriate in consultation with the Committee and/or Panel Chair.
