"It shouldn't be dumbed down....It shouldn't be a lesser version of itself"
















Pavement Condition

- Transit way pavers cost over \$1 million annually to maintain
- Pavement system is deteriorating due to age, moisture, heavy vehicle loads
- Pavers are 35 years old, past original 30-year design life
