APPLICATION DEADLINES

For priority consideration, submit by:

FALL SEMESTER - February 1 | SPRING SEMESTER - November 1 | FINANCIAL AID - March 15

Along with your application, you'll be asked to submit a \$35 application fee, test scores and an official high school transcript. Your records must show the following: completion of at least the 19 minimum course unit requirements indicated below with a grade C or better; a minimum GPA of 2.0 or better on a 4.0 scale; test scores of 800 on the SAT (math and critical reading combined), 800 or above (after concordance) on the 2016 redesigned SAT, or a 17 or better composite score on the ACT; and a diploma from an accredited four-year school or senior high school.

English	Writing, Literature and Oral Communication	4 Units
Mathematics	Courses must include Algebra I & II and Geometry or the equivalent (recommend a fourth, higher math course)	3 Units
History	One (1) World History and one (1) other History	2 Units
Social Studies	Civics, American Government, Economics, Geography or Psychology (2 units recommended)	1 Unit
Science	Courses with a laboratory. Must include one (1) or more of the following: Biology, Chemistry and/or Physics	3 Units
Foreign Language	Recommend within the same language. If within the same language, there must be course progression (Spanish I and Spanish II, French I and French II, etc.).	2 Units
Electives	May include any additional class from subject areas listed above or Art, Theatre/Drama, Music and/or Computer Science	4 Units

ENROLLMENT PATHWAYS

Not applying directly after high school? Students come to us from all stages of life with various backgrounds and levels of experience.

Transfer Along with your application and \$35 application fee, you must also submit official high school transcripts if 30 or more college-level credits have not been earned, official transcripts from all higher education institutions attended with a 2.0 or better GPA, as well as SAT or ACT test scores if not transferring in 12 college credit hours or more.
