 - b. Type N Desktop GIS analysis dispute has entered Phase 2 with a meeting likely the first full week in February
- 2) Workgroups continue to meet on budget and extensive monitoring, SAO audit recommendation workgroup is communicating via e-mail at AMPAs request. Reviewed the CMER project summary worksheets in January and one policy member asked for additional project budget approval information added to the documents.
