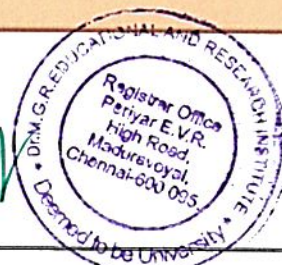

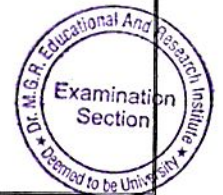

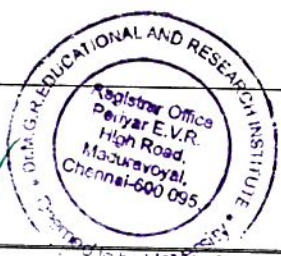

2015-16	Usage Of Automation Software Jack Prodigy	The marks obtained by the students in various assessment tools are entered in the Jackprodigy portal. 2017-18	Blooms Taxonomy	Bloom's Taxonomy provides an important framework to plan delivery of content and to design appropriate examination questions belonging to various cognitive levels. The examination questions are designed in such a way to divide learning into three types of domains cognitive, affective, and behavioral and then defines the level of performance for each domain. Conscious efforts to map the curriculum and assessment to these levels help the programs to aim for higher-level abilities which go beyond remembering or understanding, and require application, analysis, evaluation, or creation.
2017-18	Skill Development and Internship	Courses through online platforms like NPTEL/SWAYAM/MOOCs and those evaluations are included for the award of credit and marks. ETL (Embedded Theory and Lab) does enrich the students with practical skills that is required for job market.

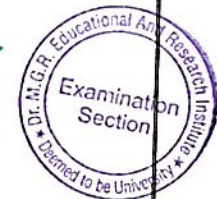
