What is Production and Ongoing Submission?

- Production and Ongoing Submission of Data are the final steps of establishing data exchange
- Production: Error free patient records sent to the registry are added to ImmTrac2
- Ongoing Submission of Data: Routine activities for monitoring and maintaining data exchange with the registry.



Requirements

- Successfully complete Data Exchange Testing:
 - Submit three to five error free test files
 - Request review by the registry
 - Receive production email



Production

- Live with the registry
- Send only true patient data
- Notify EHR vendor
- Notify registry of first production file



Historical Load

- One-time submission of historical records
- Flesh-out patient records
- Ask your EHR vendor
 - Can your EHR send a historical load?
 - How far back can it go?



Ongoing Submission

- Deliver files on a routine schedule
 - No more than once per week
 - No less than once per month
- Regularly monitor Data Quality Assurance (DQA) reports for errors
- Address all errors
- Take ownership of data quality for your patients
