## **K-12 Vaccine Requirements Table**

Vaccine	Number Required	Number Present	Comments	Notes
DTaP	5 or 4 doses			One dose on or after 4th birthday (or 4 days before). For students aged 7 years & older, 3 doses meet the requirement if 1 dose was received on or after the 4th birthday.
Tdap	1 dose			One dose is required for students entering 7th grade.
Polio	4 or 3 doses			One dose on or after 4th birthday (or 4 days before). Three doses meet the requirement if 3rd dose was received on or after the 4th birthday.
MMR	2 doses			First dose received on or after the 1st birthday (or 4 days before).
Hepatitis B	3 doses			Two doses meet the requirement if Recombivax® was received. Recombivax® must be noted on the immunization record.
Varicella	2 doses			First dose received on or after the 1st birthday (or 4 days before).
MCV4	1 dose			One dose is required on or after the student's 11th birthday. If the student received the vaccine at 10 years of age, this will satisfy the requirement.
Hepatitis A	2 doses			First dose received on or after the 1st birthday (or 4 days before) *.

<sup>\*</sup> For the 2020-2021 school year, two doses of Hepatitis A are required for students enrolled in grades K-11th. Starting in the 2021-2022 school year, two doses of Hepatitis A will be required for all students enrolled in grades K-12th.
