 - C. Texas Department of State Health Services (DSHS)
 - *i.* Mr. Vamvakias discussed the DSHS program report. Mr. Pahl discussed the request from the Legislature of a 1.1 billion dollars exceptional item to enhance the current document management system to provide our licensees a function to upload documents. The Radiation Program was able to reduce their budget by 2.5% and was able to absorb some of the personnel vacancies.
