Dr. Metter discussed the application to the NRC to use alpha emitters, Alpha Dart and CiviDerm in radiotherapy.

## C. Outlook for upcoming rule revisions

Ms. Bruedigan reported the next upcoming rules to open will be §289.229; Radiation Safety Requirements for Accelerators, Therapeutic Radiation Machines, Simulators, and Electronic Brachytherapy Devices, and §289.301; Registration and Radiation Safety Requirements for Lasers and Intense-Pulsed Light Devices.

D. Identify topics to recommend for further discussion and/or to be addressed at future meetings of the Medical Committee; Topic Research Committee; Industrial, Nuclear Power, Uranium, and Waste (INUW) Committee; or full Board

Dr. Metter recommends carrying NRC regulatory guide 8.39, Alpha Dart Therapy, Remote CT scans, and upcoming revisions of rules over to the next medical committee meeting scheduled for June.
