



U.S. diesel fuel price increases

The U.S. average retail price for on-highway diesel fuel increased to \$3.90 a gallon on Monday. That's up 3.2 cents from a week ago, based on the weekly price survey by the U.S. Energy Information Administration.

Diesel prices were highest in the West Coast states at \$4.55 a gallon, up 4.3 cents from a week ago. Prices were lowest in the Rocky Mountain region at \$3.65 a gallon, up 0.5 cents from a week ago.
